THE JOURNEY OF TRANSFIGURATION

"We used to be such good friends. How is it that you've moved so far away?" one man asked another. "Perhaps," the other replied, "you have moved away. By standing still." This exchange very well could have happened between Peter and Jesus, had Peter been allowed to erect tents to stay on the mount of the Transfiguration. He nearly succumbed to the temptation to stay in a place of wonder and light. But Jesus knew the hard truth: we are on a continual journey when we are walking the paths of God's will. It is not good for us to stay in one place on our faith journey. Equally unhealthy is staying put in times of joy and wonder to avoid life's difficulties, or to wallow in our trials and temptations and fail to be companions for our sisters and brothers who are also suffering—or celebrating! The pilgrim Church is required to do one thing on its Lenten journey: to walk continually with Christ as his Body born of water and the Spirit, seeking God's will, helping the reign of God to be known on earth, being led to the end of our journey, transfigured for all time into the company of heaven.

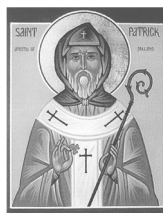
Serra Prayer for Vocations

****St. Joseph Table, Fundraiser and Feast** Next **Saturday, March 18th** we will celebrate our third annual St. Joseph Table here at OLP. Our prayer service will take place right after the 5pm Mass over in the cafeteria (around 6:10pm). This is in conjunction with the meatless Italian meal that will be served throughout the day from 12noon until 8pm to raise money for our OLP needy fund (which goes directly to OLP families in need). Please make every effort to support this special event. The Liturgical Feast of St. Joseph (typically March 19th) will be moved to **Monday, March 20th** where we will honor, and seek the intercession of, the universal patron of the church at both Masses.

****Promotion Sunday for Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) 2017** Next weekend at all the Masses we will be speaking about the annual diocesan appeal called CSA 2017. This week I will be sending a letter to all of our parishioners giving more details but allow me to remind you here how important this appeal is for the life of our Erie Diocesan Church as well as our parish. We will be showing a video from Bishop Persico before all the Masses so please make an effort to get to church early next weekend and hear about this appeal.

****St. Patrick's Day** **Friday, March 17th** is the feast of St. Patrick and this is significant not just as a fun day for those who are Irish, but more importantly St. Patrick is the patron of the Church of the entire Diocese of Erie (St. Patrick Church was our first Cathedral). This is an important day to pray for our Diocesan Church especially during this time of major transitions. So join us at one of the daily Masses, come to 24 Hours for the Lord at the Cathedral (see my letter above) or say some extra prayers on your own for our greater diocesan church.

****Confession Times for Lent** In order to encourage you to receive this Sacrament, there will be extra times to go to Confession during Lent (in addition to our normal time of Saturday from 3:45-4:45pm)- Fridays from 6-7pm; after Sunday morning Masses throughout Lent; 24 Hours for the Lord- Friday, March 17th from 9-10pm at St. Peter Cathedral; OLP Lenten Penance Service on Monday, April 3rd at 7pm. ALSO see elsewhere for Confession times and Penance Service at the other west Erie parishes.

****Extra Lenten Prayer Opportunities** Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament - Holy Hour for Vocations on Monday, March 13th at 7pm, First Friday Adoration on April 6th from 7:30am-3pm; Stations of the Cross- Fridays at 7pm; and daily Mass-7am and 12:10pm.

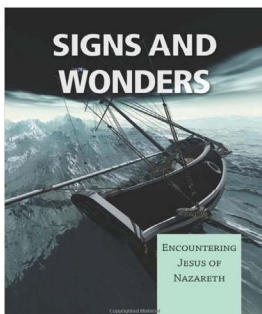
