

From the Pastor's Desk...

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

A happy belated Feast Day of St. Kateri Tekakwitha to you (it was last Friday, July 14th)! St. Kateri was the first Native American Saint and we will be visiting her shrine and tomb in Montreal during our pilgrimage to Canada in the Fall. It is not too late to sign up- see the brochures at the doors of the church or call the office for more details.

As I mentioned in the bulletin last week, we hosted the latest Vicariate Meeting for the Diocese of Erie's Pastoral Planning Process last month. At that meeting Bishop Persico and members of the Faith Formation Task Force unveiled the **preliminary plan for Faith Formation in the Diocese (Faith Formation is the newest title we use for CCD/Religious Education)**. Their recommendations deal with six key areas: lifelong formation, vision, parish leadership, diocesan leadership, the role of the family and lay ministry. The full list of recommendations are posted in a link that can be found on the website- www.eriercd.org/planning.htm.

Many people, including the Bishop, have said that this could be the most critical part of the Pastoral Planning Process for the Diocese because it is the area where we are most in need. Our CCD/ Religious Education models of the past are no longer working and we are struggling to engage our younger generations beyond our Catholic Schools. I applaud the Bishop in recognizing this area of need and looking to do something about it. We need to be creative and forward thinking in coming up with programs beyond the classrooms to help our youth and adults grow in a living relationship with God.

The Bishop and task force members are asking parishioners in the Diocese of Erie to offer their feedback to the plan between June 16 and July 28, 2017. An online survey and instructions are provided in the links provided on the same website mentioned above. I am soliciting input for a parish wide institutional response from our staff, Pastoral Council, Families Together Ministry Team, RCIA Team and Faith Formation Committee, but your individual responses are also very important. I hope you will take the time to read the information found online and fill out the survey. On Sunday, July 16th we will also have coffee and donuts with iPads available in the cafeteria after all Masses to assist you in filling out the survey.

So please take advantage of this opportunity to be a part of this important phase in our diocesan church's history and to be a part of the solution in bringing the truth of Christ to our church and our world. Let me know if you have any questions or concerns.

May God bless our Faith Formation Planning and our week ahead!






