Today, the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, is a day of eyewitness accounts. The first, a vision reported by the prophet Daniel, was well known to Jesus and his apostles. The vision account was written in quite mystical and figurative language. It is a vision of heaven, powerful and memorable. There are flames of fire, burning wheels, the Ancient One, and a Son of Man. Clearly, Daniel saw something. But was it a dream? Was it real? Was it merely a clever myth?

Peter wants no such confusion about his vision! We are told in Matthew's Gospel what he and his friends James and John saw when they went up on the mountain with Jesus one day. Jesus warned the three witnesses to tell no one until "the Son of Man has been raised from the dead" (Matthew 17:9). Lest readers of one of the Gospels discount the story or simply write it off as a pious myth, Peter gives his own account of the Transfiguration of Jesus in his second letter to the church. He writes with authority, as an eyewitness. He reports this message from God concerning Jesus: "This is my Son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased," and he assures us that the message is "altogether reliable" (2 Peter 1:17, 19).

From the Pastor's Desk...

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

Happy feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Christ! This day celebrates the revelation of Christ's divine glory on Mount Tabor in Galilee (Matthew 17:1-6; Mark 9:1-8; Luke 9:28-36). After revealing to His disciples that He would be put to death in Jerusalem (Matthew 16:21), Christ, along with Ss. Peter, James, and John, went up the mountain. There, Saint Matthew writes, "he was transfigured before them. And his face did shine as the sun: and his garments became white as snow." The brightness with which He shone on Mount Tabor was not something added to Christ but the manifestation of His true divine nature. For Peter, James, and John, it was also a glimpse of the glories of Heaven and of the resurrected body promised to all Christians. When Christ was transfigured, two others appeared with Him: Moses, representing the Old Testament Law, and Elijah, representing the prophets. Thus Christ, Who stood between the two and spoke with them, appeared to the disciples as the fulfillment of both the Law and the prophets. At Christ's baptism in the Jordan River, the voice of God the Father was heard to proclaim that "This is my beloved Son" (Matthew 3:17). During the Transfiguration, God the Father pronounced the same words (Matthew 17:5).

Despite the importance of this event, the Feast of the Transfiguration was not among the earliest of feasts celebrated by Christians. It was first celebrated in Asia starting in the fourth or fifth century and spread throughout the Christian East in the centuries following. The Catholic Encyclopedia notes that it was not commonly celebrated in the West until the tenth century. Pope Callixtus III elevated the Transfiguration to a feast of the universal Church and established August 6 as the date of its celebration. Most recently the event which the church celebrates today was included among the new luminous mysteries by St. Pope John Paul II in 2002 which also reinforces the significance of this feast among the events in Jesus' public ministry.

We pray that whatever crosses we may be carrying or facing in our lives right now, that our encounter with that same glorious Lord Jesus Christ at Mass can give us hope and courage as it did for the Apostles. May God bless our week ahead!

****Tuesday, August 15th is the Feast of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is a Holy Day of Obligation.** Masses at OLP will be Monday, August 14th at 5:30pm and Tuesday, August 15th at 7am and 12:10pm.

****Youth and Vocation Holy Hour** Our next one is **Monday, August 14th at 6:30pm** (right after the Vigil Mass for the Assumption). Please note that this is a Holy Hour with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Praise and Worship Songs and prayer and meditation. It is for BOTH YOUTH AND ADULTS to pray for our youth and for vocations to the priesthood and religious life (as well as holy marriages and single life).

****OLP Generosity and Thank You's** I continue to be amazed by the generosity of our parish ranging from service and volunteerism to financial support. I want to recognize several areas that financial generosity has been manifest in the last few months going in reverse chronological order. **First** of all and most recently, thank you to everyone who helped welcome and support **Fr. Emmanuel Fale-Lon from the Diocese of Kumbo (Cameroon Africa)** to Our Lady of Peace last weekend. So far OLP has donated over \$8,000 to this mission of helping poor children in Kumbo. **Second**, I am grateful to all those who helped support the **OLP Golf Outing** several weeks ago. We raised over \$4,000 for the church and school. A special thank you goes out to Paul and Diane Vojtek and their team of volunteers who organized and ran the event as well as all the players and sponsors. **Third**, we recently received two **stone memorial benches** in front of our outdoor Marian shrine in memory of Ron Erb (longtime Business Manager at OLP who died in January) and Mark Borrowy (longtime and active parishioner at OLP who died in May). I thank members of the staff and parish who donated the bench for Ron and the Families Together Ministry who donated the bench for Mark (Mark was a part of FTM). We will bless the benches later in the summer at a time to be determined. **Fourth**, back in June we received a new set of **White Mass Vestments** for the Christmas and Easter Seasons from the OLP Rosary Society. It included a main celebrant chasuble, two concelebrating chasubles, two dalmatics for deacons and accompanying stoles for each which all totaled \$3,926. **Fifth**, over the last year the OLP Knights of Columbus were able to purchase **two new ultrasound machines** for local pregnancy centers. They received help from other Knights from the Erie area as well as the Supreme Council for our country and many of you donated towards the \$46,000 price tag as well. We blessed the machines at the Peach Street location this past Tuesday at 6pm. This list is not exhaustive but I wanted to bring special attention to these generous donations.

****Diocese of Erie Pastoral Planning Feedback on Faith Formation (CCD/Religious Education)** Bishop Persico and members of the Faith Formation Task Force unveiled the **preliminary plan for Faith Formation in the Diocese (Faith Formation is the newest title we use for CCD/Religious Education)** last month. Their recommendations deal with six key areas: lifelong formation, vision, parish leadership, diocesan leadership, the role of the family and lay ministry. The list of recommendations are posted in a link that can be found on the website- www.eriercd.org/planning.htm. The Bishop and task force members are asking parishioners in the Diocese of Erie to offer their feedback to the plan until **August 28, 2017**. An online survey and instructions are provided in the links on the same website. I hope you will take the time to read the information found online and fill out the survey therefore be a part of this important phase in our diocesan church's history and to be a part of the solution in bringing the truth of Christ to our church and our world.


