

All rights reserved.**CALLED TO ACT IN GOD'S NAME**

"Let all the nations praise you!" (Psalm 67:4) today's psalm response exclaims. In the psalms and other Hebrew scriptures, this kind of invocation is actually an invitation to God to act, to intervene in human lives in a manner that will cause everyone—not just the Chosen People—to give praise. Stated a bit more strongly, it is something of a "put up or shut up" challenge to God, the sort of strong statement the psalmists of Israel, trusting in their intimate and loving relationship with God, were not afraid to make.

The Gospel has its own exclamation, announcing the appearance of the Canaanite woman with "Behold!" (Matthew 15:22) "Behold!" is a scriptural flag that tells us that God is about to act or announce something through an individual or a situation. In the case of Jesus, God was going to act through this woman, whom nobody among Jesus' followers would have believed to be an agent of the divine will. Like the psalmists, we might passively inform or perhaps even actively challenge God to do something so that everyone will come to belief, but God will always turn the tables on us. It becomes our calling, our duty (as it was for Jesus) to behold the situations and persons of our daily lives so that God can act through us, so the Kingdom can be announced through our living. **From the Pastor's Desk...**

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

This past week the Unified Erie's Religiosity Committee again initiated a county-wide publicity campaign called "Take Me to Worship." Running from mid August until the end of October, there will be advertising on TV, radio, billboards and social media. They made the same effort last year but the difference this year is that the Catholic Church is participating more actively. Every Catholic church in the county has received a limited number of yard signs and car decals through a Diocesan Evangelization Grant. We were able to acquire more signs and decals for OLP through the generosity of Dr. Warren and Christine Beaver.

The concept behind this initiative is that data shows that those who participate in worship are less likely to be involved in violence, or use drugs or alcohol, or commit suicide. So "Take Me to Worship" encourages regular, weekly participation in organized religious institutions. The theme is from a child's perspective- asking their parents to take them to worship so as to give them a better chance to avoid these evils that are plaguing our society. Obviously, this is not a new concept to us Catholics but it is a great opportunity to join with other religious communities to promote what is something central to all of us... and to reinforce the serious responsibility that our parents have in getting their children to Mass because it makes a big impact on their the human formation of their children.

Please consider taking a car decal to promote this important initiative and also consider encouraging some one in your family, a friend or your neighbor to take their children to worship.

**\*\*Diocese of Erie Pastoral Planning Feedback on Faith Formation (CCD/Religious Education)** Bishop Persico and members of the Faith Formation Task Force unveiled the **preliminary plan for Faith Formation in the Diocese (Faith Formation is the newest title we use for CCD/Religious Education) last month**. Their recommendations deal with six key areas: lifelong formation, vision, parish leadership, diocesan leadership, the role of the family and lay ministry. *Chris Padgett*


