BE A ROCK

Peter's history as a follower or friend of Jesus is a bit spotty. It might be natural to wonder if Jesus, in giving him the keys to the kingdom, didn't feel a bit like a parent giving a teenager the keys to the family car. But it was at the moment when God's power and presence broke through everything else to raise up Peter's great profession of faith in Christ as Messiah that Jesus chose to establish the bond between the loving, forgiving mercy of heaven and our vocation to be witnesses of that love, mercy, and forgiveness on earth.

Like any parent, Jesus no doubt foresaw the failings, the irresponsible maneuvers or impaired senses, the collisions that the church would be headed for. But, most importantly, he also saw us at that moment as God prefers to see us: capable of manifesting great faith, with a willingness to remain at the feet of Christ to understand what it truly means to be Messiah and Christ. As the letter to the Romans points out to us today, we have not known the mind or the wisdom of God, but God knows us and still chooses to manifest the reign of justice, joy, beauty, and peace through us. Let this be our vocation. Let us always strive to be solid ground on which the church of Jesus Christ can be founded and on which it can continue to be built.

A new school year is here in Erie, PA! I wish blessings upon all of the students from our parish, both Catholic and public, as they begin a new academic year from pre-school to graduate school. I look forward to starting a new year of Religious Education in a few weeks as well. I am also excited to begin my first full year with OLP School and the new Erie Catholic School System (ECSS) and to do everything I can to support and grow Catholic Education, which is an intricate part of our parish mission.

I have mentioned before that I am a product of Catholic School's for 21 years (so I might be a little bias!) and I have much to be grateful to our Catholic Church for its commitment to Catholic Education over the years. But even if I did not benefit directly from Catholic Education, it would be hard for me not to see the huge contribution that Catholic Schools make, not just to our church, but our society. It is a true gift to the whole community of Erie County to offer faith and value based education. Because of that, I hope we can all renew our commitment to this valuable contribution our parish makes to the greater community.

In addition to your financial and verbal support of our school, I ask you to please pray for a renewal in our parish mission in Catholic Education. One specific way you can pray is to join us for our **opening school Mass on Monday, August 28th at 9am**. We will begin the first day of the school year with Mass because it is our God who is the source and purpose of our school and there is no better way to celebrate that than the Mass. We also seek His inspiration for the school year ahead, especially with the new system being implemented and worked out. After this week, our school Mass will be **every Thursday at 9:00am** and all parents and grandparents are encouraged to join us each week. One effect of ECSS on OLP is that Fr. Kyle and I will be celebrating the School Mass once a month while visiting priests from the Erie area will cover the other weeks. We will try to announce in the bulletin each week who will be presiding at the school Mass.

Other notes from the pastor...

****Our OLP Parish Picnic is Saturday, September 9th from 5-10pm.**

We will have an outdoor Mass on the EAST LAWN at the intersection of 38th and Pacific Ave. (PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGE IN LOCATION) at 5pm with dinner, music, a bonfire and activities to follow. I expect everyone in our parish to make every effort to be there. To reinforce this expectation we will NOT have the 7:30am and 11am Masses that Sunday morning (Sunday, September 10th there ONLY will be 9am and 4:30pm Masses at OLP). See elsewhere in the bulletin for more details.

****Saturday, September 16th is the Third Annual "Faithful to the Finish" 5K Race** for School Tuition assistance. The race is held at 8am at Beach One on the peninsula. Many volunteers are needed; please consider volunteering. More details are on the back cover.

****Take Me to Worship Campaign** Last week the Unified Erie's Religiosity Committee again initiated a county-wide publicity campaign called "Take Me to Worship." Running from mid-August until the end of October, there will be advertising on TV, radio, billboards and social media. They made the same effort last year but the difference this year is that the Catholic Church is participating more actively. Every Catholic Church in the county (36) has received a limited number of yard signs and car decals through a Diocesan Evangelization Grant. We were able to acquire more signs and decals for OLP through the generosity of Dr. Warren and Christine Beaver.

The concept behind this initiative is that data shows that those who participate in religious activities for at least one hour per week are less likely to be involved in violence, abuse drugs or alcohol, commit suicide, and experience depression. So "Take Me to Worship" encourages regular, weekly participation in organized religious institutions. The theme is from a child's perspective- asking their parents to take them to worship so as to give them a better chance to avoid these evils that are plaguing our society.

Obviously, this is not a new concept to us Catholics but it is a great opportunity to join with other religious communities to promote what is something central to all of us... and to reinforce the serious responsibility that our parents have in getting their children to Mass because it makes a big impact on their the human formation of their children. Please take a car decal to promote this important initiative (at the office or doors of the church) and also consider encouraging someone in your family, a friend or your neighbor to take their children to worship.

****Our Parish Mission entitled "Called to be Saints" and led by Chris Padgett, is September 17-19.** Parish Missions are meant to be an opportunity for renewal of the parish beyond the normal activity of the parish. They are days to be set aside by all parishioners so we will have no other parish activity going on other than that which is affiliated with the mission. Chris will speak at all of our Sunday Masses that weekend and then have presentations each night (Sunday- 6:30pm; Monday and Tuesday at 7pm). There will also be two talks given after daily Mass (1pm on Monday and 7:45am on Tuesday). Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Confessions and other prayer opportunities will also be included- all geared toward a chance for us to be spiritually refreshed and reinvigorated.

Chris Padgett

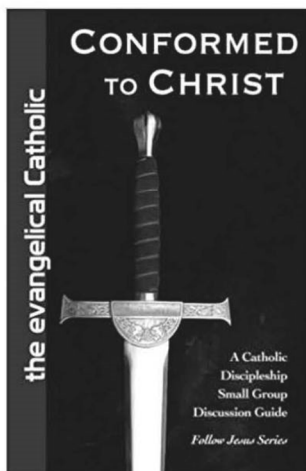
