**FOLLOWING CHRIST**

If you've ever had an unpleasant but somewhat amusing practical joke played on you, then you have some understanding of how Jeremiah feels today when he tells God "good one—you duped me." We can almost see him shaking his head with a bit of a rueful smile, but an angry undertone in his voice. In similar fashion, Peter thinks Jesus is "duping" him when Jesus starts to explain that being Messiah means suffering and dying, and being a follower of the Messiah means taking up a cross and doing the same. Jeremiah tries to deny God's will for him by trying to shut up; Peter—who has just been made the foundation of the church—out and out denies the teaching of Jesus, for which he is named "Satan" today. Fortunately for us, Jeremiah comes to realize that to have the word of God placed in your heart means that it will be futile to try and keep silent, even if it means scorn and derision from those around you. Luckily Peter ultimately returned to the faith he professed in last week's Gospel, and came to understand our need as baptized followers of Christ to follow in his way, even when it means following him to our very death.

**Other notes from the pastor...**

**\*\*Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults** Are you or anyone you know considering becoming Catholic or completing your Initiation as a Catholic by getting Confirmed? If so, please call Fr. Rich or Tammie Mang at the parish office now since classes begin this **Wednesday at 6:30pm** in the OLP School.

**\*\*Our OLP Parish Picnic is Saturday, September 9<sup>th</sup> from 5-10pm.** We will have an outdoor Mass on the EAST LAWN at the intersection of 38<sup>th</sup> and Pacific Ave. (PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGE IN LOCATION) at 5pm with dinner, music, a bonfire and activities to follow. I expect everyone in our parish to make every effort to be there. To reinforce this expectation we will NOT have the 7:30am and 11am Masses that Sunday morning (Sunday, September 10<sup>th</sup> there ONLY will be 9am and 4:30pm Masses at OLP). See elsewhere in the bulletin for more details.

**\*\*Saturday, September 16<sup>th</sup> is the Third Annual "Faithful to the Finish" 5K Race** for School Tuition assistance. The race is held at 8am at Beach One on the peninsula. Many volunteers are needed; please consider volunteering. More details are on the back cover.

**\*\*Take Me to Worship Campaign** The concept behind this initiative is that data shows that those who participate in religious activities for at least one hour per week are less likely to be involved in violence, abuse drugs or alcohol, commit suicide, and experience depression. So "Take Me to Worship" encourages regular, weekly participation in organized religious institutions. Please take a car decal (at the office or doors of the church) or a yard sign (at the office) to promote this important initiative and also consider encouraging someone in your family, a friend or your neighbor to take their children to worship.

**\*\*Our Parish Mission entitled "Called to be Saints" and led by Chris Padgett, is September 17-19.** Parish Missions are meant to be an opportunity for renewal of the parish beyond the normal activity of the parish. They are days to be set aside by all parishioners so we will have no other parish activity going on other than that which is affiliated with the mission. Chris will speak at all of our Sunday Masses that weekend and then have presentations each night (Sunday- 6:30pm; Monday and Tuesday at 7pm). There will also be two talks given after daily Mass (1pm on Monday and 7:45am on Tuesday). Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Confessions and other prayer opportunities will also be included- all geared toward a chance for us to be spiritually refreshed and reinvigorated.

**\*\*Properties Update** Over the last month, our staff has been working hard at getting our campus ready for a new school and faith formation year. We were able to give the parking lot a double seal as well as crack filling and line painting. The Act 89 room in the school had a major leak fixed as well as painting and new carpeting. The old computer lab next to the library received new carpeting after removing the tile floor and is now one of our three preschool rooms. A new sign for the Erie Catholic School System will be going up in the next month and the school entry way project (expanding the entry and adding a security vestibule) and science lab renovations have been planned for next summer. All these improvements were accomplished through our parish operating budget as well as our school advancement budget so your generous offertory at Mass and your support of the school are being put to good work.

**\*\*Wish List** Thank you to an OLP Parish Family for their contribution to our wish list needs. Remaining items: altar cloth for the tabernacle that costs \$300; Book of the Gospels at \$200; and the Rite of Marriage at \$40. **\*\*New Crucifix in Gym** Thank you to the Austin and Jill Brugger Family as well as the School Athletic Board for their generosity in donating a new five foot crucifix to our gym (\$1,975). This is a great way to witness to our faith in Jesus Christ and to remember that our faith is part of all of our lives including our recreation and sports!

**\*\*School Masses** Fr. Kyle will be celebrating our school Mass this **Thursday at 9:00am** and all parents and grandparents are encouraged to join us. One effect of ECSS on OLP is that Fr. Kyle and I will be celebrating the School Mass once a month while visiting priests from the Erie area will cover the other weeks. We will try to announce in the bulletin each week who will be presiding at the school Mass.

Fifteen months ago, members of the Knights of Columbus at Our Lady of Peace in Erie read about Brother Knights from Our Lady of the Lake in Edinboro raising funds to purchase an Ultrasound Machine for Boro Women & Family Services also in Edinboro. The Women's Care Center of Erie had two very old units that were in need of replacement. Getting them to operate properly was becoming more and more challenging. Once the members of the Knights of Columbus at Our Lady of Peace learned about this need, they made a commitment to work toward raising the needed funds to purchase two new units, the price tag, \$46,090.

Through the generosity of the Parishioners of Our Lady of Peace along with significant funds from the Knights of Columbus there with support from other Knights of Columbus Councils, and a matching program by the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council in New Haven, Connecticut, the funds were raised in a few months. Knights of Columbus from St Jude the Apostle in Erie and Msgr. MJ Urbonas in Dubois were extremely giving in their support along with Knights of Columbus from Sacred Heart in Erie, Our Lady of the Lake in Edinboro, St Gregory in North East, Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Erie, St Mark the Evangelist in Lawrence Park, St Boniface in Erie and the Archbishop Gannon Fourth Degree Assembly.

Statistics show that when a woman considering abortion sees an ultrasound picture of the unborn child in her womb, that mother will overwhelmingly choose life. Thus the vital importance of ultrasound machines. They provide a "window to the womb." The goal of the Knights of Columbus was to have these units save one life. The Women's Care Center is happy to report that several women who were convinced that abortion was the only answer to their pregnancy have chosen life for their babies after seeing ultrasound pictures. Through the Knights of Columbus Ultrasound Initiative, since 2009, state and local Knights of Columbus councils have teamed up with the Supreme Council to fund over 752 ultrasound machines, costing over \$36 million, for placement in pro-life pregnancy care centers (PCCs) in all 50 states, as well as in Canada, Guatemala, Jamaica, and Peru. The Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic men's fraternal organization with 1.9 million members throughout the United States, Canada, the Philippines, Mexico, Poland, the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, Panama, the Bahamas, the Virgin Islands, Cuba, Guatemala, Guam, Saipan, Lithuania, Ukraine, and South Korea.
