**GOD HAS A DIFFERENT PLAN**

We begin the season of Advent with a heartfelt call for our own repentance. We remember God's faithful love for us, and call upon God to help us to turn back. For "behold, you are angry, and we are sinful" (Isaiah 64:4). In the first reading and in the psalm, we recall God's promises and lament our unfaithfulness and our guilt. We call upon God's might and power in order to save us. With Isaiah, we ask God to "rend the heavens and come down, / with the mountains quaking before you" (Isaiah 63:19).

Yes, God is faithful to us, because we are the work of God's hands. God is the potter, we are the clay. And yet, our concept of how God will come to save us is rooted in our own expectations of a warrior God who crushes mountains and thunders into our lives with great noise and glory. But God has a different plan: the Incarnation.

From the Pastor's Desk...

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

Happy New Year (liturgically speaking) and a blessed Advent to you! The word advent comes from the Latin "adventus" which means "coming." We ready ourselves for the Second Coming of Christ at the Final Judgment while remembering the true meaning of His first coming on that first Christmas Day. Advent has been a period of preparation for over 1,500 years of the Church's tradition. It has always had a spirit of penance and fasting, as well as a spirit of waiting through silence and prayer. So as we start a new liturgical year, it is a great time to recommit ourselves to new or old "spiritual resolutions." Consider coming to daily Mass, praying the rosary regularly, fasting, spending time daily in meditation, read the Bible, stop by the church regularly for a visit, come to adoration (see below for opportunities) or whatever else God inspires you to do. This spiritual preparation can help us keep the true meaning of Christmas in focus so as to not become consumed with the "other" Christmas preparations of shopping, baking, wrapping, planning, cooking, decorating, etc., etc. So think and pray about what your personal New Year's spiritual resolutions could be, make a commitment, stick with it and I promise you that will truly encounter Christ more fully this Christmas!

One of the most significant spiritual actions/resolutions to consider during Advent is to participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As Advent is a season of new beginnings...Reconciliation is THE Sacrament of new beginnings. Advent is the season of preparing for Jesus...Reconciliation is THE Sacrament which prepares us to commune with Him more fully and effectively. Advent takes us back to the moment our human family received the fullness of God's life and love through Jesus Christ...Reconciliation is the Sacrament that renews and strengthens in us that grace of the moment of our first encounter with Christ in Baptism. In Advent we celebrate the incarnation of God's mercy and love in the person of Jesus of Nazareth...Reconciliation is an incarnational, concrete, tangible experience of God's mercy and love. So there is no more appropriate and effective way to prepare for the gift of Christ and Christmas than to experience Reconciliation.

With that in mind, we are coordinating four Penance Services with the other west Erie parishes which are....**Our Lady of Peace- Monday, December 11<sup>th</sup>**; Blessed Sacrament- Thursday, December 14<sup>th</sup>; St. George- Sunday, December 17<sup>th</sup>; and St. Jude-Thursday, December 21<sup>st</sup>. All the services will start at 7pm. We will also have individual confessions available after every Sunday morning Mass in Advent; as well as after the daily Masses on Friday, December 22 and after both Saturday Masses on December 23 (8am and 5pm). Also, we will continue our practice of individual confessions on all the Saturdays of Advent from 3:45-4:45pm. And as always Fr. Kyle and I would be happy to set up an appointment with you for Confession if these other opportunities do not fit your schedule. I cannot encourage you enough to take advantage of this great Sacrament this Advent.

May God bless our Advent Season of preparing our hearts for Jesus' coming and our week ahead!

**\*\*My Parish App Launch** Last weekend we launched the Our Lady of Peace myParish App thanks to the efforts of the Diocese of Erie. This is part of our pursuit of new opportunities to foster stronger parish life and better engage in the New Evangelization. This App for smart phones (Apple and Android) allows us to send you useful and important messages throughout the week regarding our parish life and events and allows you to reply to messages or RSVP for events. The app has many great features including an alert to remind you to silence your phone 20 minutes before the Mass you select, daily Mass readings, Catholic news, prayers and prayer reminders, and quick access to online tithing, Confession reminders and our weekly bulletin. So be sure to download the APP by visiting myparishapp.com or searching for myparish on your phone's app store. See below for further instructions.

**\*\* OLP Adoration Opportunities** One- First Friday in the Blessed Mother Chapel (this Friday, December 1<sup>st</sup>) from 7:30am until 3pm benediction; two- Youth and Vocation Holy Hour in the church, which is typically the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month from 7-8pm (next one is December 18<sup>th</sup>); and three- Encounter in the chapel, which is a children's guided meditation with Adoration held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of every month from 4-4:45pm (the next one is December 12<sup>th</sup>).

Beyond OLP, there is Perpetual Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Joseph/Bread of Life Chapel in the Parish Center at 147 West 24<sup>th</sup> Street in Erie. That means 24 hours a day, 7 days a week you can adore our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament there. This is a great resource for the Catholic Church in Erie and I encourage everyone to take advantage of it. There is a code to get in the chapel after office hours so contact me if you are interested and do not know the code.

#### ONESIE Fundraiser for ProLife Youth Fund




