Today we encounter readings that draw us into the mystery of suffering and death. In the past few years we have witnessed the devastation of life and property through earthquakes and hurricanes. So many lifted their lament to God, simply asking, "Why?" This is an honest expression of anger toward a God who we believe is the giver of life. When we lose a loved one, we can wonder why the presence of Christ is not enough to make that person rise, even from death, as did the little girl in today's Gospel passage. Again we raise our voices and ask, "Why?" At moments such as these, let us make the prayer of the psalmist our own: "Hear, O LORD, and have pity on me; O LORD, be my helper." Let us pray that our mourning will one day be turned into dancing.

### From the Pastor's Desk...

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

Happy July Fourth Week! As I mentioned last weekend, the Fortnight for Freedom is from June 21 (the vigil of the Feasts of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More) to July 4, Independence Day. Since 2010, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have encouraged dioceses around the country to highlight the importance of defending religious freedom as we approach Independence Day. "Religion [cannot] be relegated to the inner sanctum of personal life, without influence on societal and national life." -Pope Francis, *Evangelii Gaudium*, 183. If religious liberty is not respected, all people suffer and are deprived of the essential contribution to the common good, be it in education, health care, feeding the hungry, civil rights, and social services that the Church and other people of faith make every day, both here at home and overseas.

Religious liberty will continue to be a special intention at our daily Masses during this stretch and I encourage you to find ways to incorporate this intention in your daily prayers. Also, our daily parish rosary at 11:35am will include this intention. We also will pray for our country in an intentional way at **Mass on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup> at 9am**. We pray that our country can value true freedom as the freedom to choose what is right and good and holy and NOT just value the ability to choose as all that matters. As Catholics, we celebrate freedom at every Mass. It is the greatest freedom Jesus won for us on the Cross, that is freedom from sin and death (the ONLY things that can separate us from the love of God). So as we join our country in being grateful for our legal freedoms that she is founded on, let's make sure to not forget to be grateful for the spiritual freedoms that are even more important from the eternal perspective.

**\*\*PA Grand Jury Report UPDATE** I continue to be impressed with the morale of our clergy AND laity of our Diocesan Church despite all that has been going on with the Pennsylvania Grand Jury regarding child abuse. I am grateful for all of you who have

expressed support as well as asking how I am doing with all of this. As I have expressed to you in the past, I continue to be hopeful that God will bring new life and growth from this darkness. In communicating to all of you, I have tried to find a fine line of not ignoring the issue but also not obsessing/ overstating it. Last weekend I warned you that the final Grand Jury Report would be made public soon. That changed this past week when the PA Supreme Court granted a stay for that report which means it is now delayed indefinitely. Bishop Persico quickly released a statement that the Diocese of Erie was not the party that blocked this release and it seems clear that none of the 6 diocese involved are behind the halt.

As I said last weekend, if and when the report is made public, I believe this will be the lowest point of this whole process, with much media coverage and details of abuses from the past. It will be hard but we will persevere. I always tell you to focus your energy on what you know and not what might or could happen so I do not want to say much more about this. But I also know that forewarning can help absorb some of the shock that can come from difficult news. So let's pray for the grace to absorb this news with dignity and grace and then wait to see what we have to deal with.


