**STRENGTHENED BY THE BREAD OF LIFE**

Today we resume the "Bread of Life" discourse from John's Gospel that began two weeks ago. He makes reference to the Jews' ancestors who ate manna in the desert. These days we would think primarily of Israel wandering in the desert, but faithful Jews would also have known the story of Elijah that we hear today. Strengthened by food and drink in the desert, the angel of the Lord sends him on his forty-day and forty-night journey (the biblical number for a preparation time). Like the food given to Elijah in the desert, Jesus tells his listeners that he is bread for the life of the world. It is very important that we not stop listening to Jesus after his promise of eternal life—a marvelous promise, but this "reward" is not the only reason we feast on the Bread of Life. We also come to the table to be made strong for the journey of mission, that the whole world might have life in the fullness of Christ. We are compelled, if we have eaten of the bread of life, to go forth in service to all.

\*\*Please see the note from Deacon Joe Yochim regarding his homily three weeks ago. I will be following up with my letter on this in next weekend's bulletin (August 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>) and addressing the parish at all the Masses that same weekend. We will also have a parish wide gathering in the Fall to facilitate an open conversation about the issue of same sex attraction as well as other gender issues and how we as a Catholic community can respond to these issues in a loving way, that is consistent with our Catholic moral tradition. **\*\*The Pennsylvania Grand Jury Report on Children Sexual Abuse from the District Attorney** This report was supposed to be released last week or this week. I addressed this report back in June and repeat what I said then... I believe this will be/is the lowest point of this whole process, with much media coverage and details of abuses from the past. It will be/is hard but we will persevere. Let's pray for the grace to absorb this news with dignity and grace and continue to pray for healing and strength for all victims of abuse at the hands of the church. If anyone would like to talk about how this is affecting you, or you have ideas about how we can deal with this news and this issue as a parish, please call or email me. I again commend you on your patience, perseverance and hope in the midst of this process and I believe God desires to bring healing and new life from this suffering and cross. Come Holy Spirit.

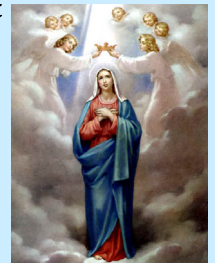
**\*\*Gratitude for our first Vacation Bible School at OLP**

**Note from Deacon Joe Yochim:**

I have received much feedback about my July 22nd homily about the importance of living a life of prayer in order to avoid the dangers and influences of our culture. I used two examples. The first was how opinions on the same-sex lifestyle have changed due to an abundance of normalization on television. The second example was how commercials change our opinions as well. In using these examples, it was not my intent to condemn one group of people. Yet some of the feedback I have received (which is quite troubling to me) revealed that condemnation is the message some people heard. I am deeply saddened that anyone felt that I was being intolerant or encouraging judgment or hatred toward anyone. I apologize that this was the message some people received. I want to be clear that we, as Christians, are called to follow the example of Jesus in loving the sinner while calling them to conversion. We are all sinful human beings worthy of love and respect.

I do, however, believe that we need to look to the Church for guidance on the topic as well. I would encourage everyone to look at Paragraphs 2357-2359 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church for a complete explanation of the topic from the Catholic Church's teaching.

These past few weeks have made it clear that there are concerns in our community regarding the same-sex issue. As a result, we are planning to hold a discussion on this topic sometime in the fall. In the meantime let's keep praying and asking for the Holy Spirit to guide us.

**“Silver Rose” to be on Display at Our Lady of Peace on Tuesday, August 21st**

As a way to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe and promote the pro-life cause, the Knights of Columbus Silver Rose will pass through the Erie Diocese from August 17-22. **Our Lady of Peace Church** will serve as one the sites on **Tuesday, August 21, 2018, at 7:00PM** where the Silver Rose will be displayed as it makes its way across the United States. There will be a Prayer Service starting at 7:00PM.

The Silver Rose was actually a dedication to St. Juan Diego and his meeting with Our Lady and the Miracle of the Roses, when he went back to the governor and was told to tell him to build a church on the site. The governor was skeptical and told him to bring a sign. The Blessed Mother told him to go to the top of the mountain and pick roses that were out of season. He put the roses in his tunic and dropped it by the governor and Our Lady’s image was emblazoned on his cloak and is still visible today.



The Knights of Columbus not only honor Our Lady but we also reaffirm dedication to the sanctity of human life. “One Life, One Rose,” and it’s now a pro-life emblem. We hope that when people see this, they will think and pray for the end of abortion.
