**THE HIGHEST LAW**

From time to time, newspapers and magazines will offer, as an item of "filler," various laws that are still on the books but seem silly to us in our day and age. In one California city, it is illegal to have two indoor bathtubs in one house. Clean water, a precious commodity when the law was written, is now readily available, so the law seems silly. But the human value of protecting and preserving precious resources is still around, evident in many conservation laws that seem sensible to us. So it is with the laws of religious tradition. What Jesus scorns today is others' attitude toward ritual laws, an attitude that becomes nearly idolatrous when laws are observed for their own sake. Jesus teaches that observation of external ritual laws is of value only when they are emblems of our internal disposition toward the will of God. Our whole lives must follow the one ultimate law of God: to love God completely and to love neighbor entirely. Roman Catholicism is a tradition rich with customs, traditions, and even laws. As we continue to listen to the voice of Christ, we must always look into our own hearts and underneath our ritual practices to make sure that love of God and love of neighbor are what we prize above all.

A blessed Labor Day Weekend and unofficial start to the Fall Season to all of you! I am excited to announce that we have hired a new part time Director of Youth Ministry here at Our Lady of Peace Parish. Mr. Corey Ferraro, a parishioner of OLP, started for us last Monday when he also started as the new middle school religion teacher at OLP School. Corey and his wife Julie (who is a teacher's aide for Kindergarten at the school) have two children- Michael (6<sup>th</sup> grade) and Theresa (4<sup>th</sup> Grade) who attend the school as well. Corey joins us after 15 years of teaching theology at Cathedral Prep as well as supervising many clubs and activities there. Prior to that, he ran the youth ministry and religious education programs at St. George Parish for four years. Corey has an undergraduate degree from Gannon University in Theology with a Master's degree in Pastoral Ministry. With this background and experience, we are very blessed to have Corey join our pastoral staff and I hope you will help me welcome him to this new role in our parish!



While we welcome Corey, I want to inform you of a new position on our staff that we have created in response to the Pastoral Council's recommendation last year. We are seeking a part time **Communications Coordinator** who will help oversee our social media communications as well as evaluating areas that we can grow in our effort to communicate our mission here at Our Lady of Peace more effectively. **\*\*OLP Parish Picnic** Our parish picnic is **NEXT WEEKEND, Saturday, September 8<sup>th</sup>**! Please note that the **outdoor Mass will start at 4:30pm instead of 5pm** (and confessions will be from 3:15-4:15pm). Also note that the Mass will be held to the south of the scout house with the congregation sitting in the parking lot (bring your own chairs!). Several people commented that the grass was difficult for people to walk on so we moved the location slightly. More details on the picnic are elsewhere in the bulletin. I hope you

received the letter I sent last week with those details as well as details on the Faithful to the Finish 5K on Saturday, September 15<sup>th</sup>. I also included other fall events and activities so please mark your calendars.

**\*\*Labor Day** On **Monday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>** we will have **Mass at 9am** for the sanctification of human work and for those who are unemployed and seeking work. This is a good weekend to be reminded that our Catholic tradition teaches us that God desires to sanctify us through our work rather than having our work be an obstacle to our holiness. So we collectively ask God to help us to allow our employment to strengthen our human dignity and to be part of the process of us growing in holiness.

**\*\*Wish List-Social Room Chairs** I would like to replace the chairs in our parish social room (basement of the church) since the present chairs have become quite worn and stained over the years. The cost of each chair is \$40.00 and we would like to reach \$2,000 or 50 chairs total. Please contact the parish office if you are interested in donating one or more chairs. Thank you for your consideration.

**\*\*Anointing of the Sick Mass** Last spring we had a special Mass during which we administered the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and over 70 people received the grace of the anointing. Due to this response and in consultation with the staff and liturgy committee we have decided to have two such Masses a year. Our next one will be Sunday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> at I Am Mass. Remember that this sacrament is **NOT FOR EVERYONE** but for those who fit in one of the following categories:

those who are dangerously ill through sickness or old age (physical or psychological)

a sick person...before surgery whenever the surgery is necessitated by a dangerous illness

elderly people...if they are weak, though not dangerously ill  
sick children...sufficiently mature to be comforted by the sacrament

sick people who have lost consciousness or who have lost the use of reason...if ...they would have requested it if they had been in possession of their faculties

Of course, if a sick person who received this anointing recovers his/her health, he/she can in the case of another serious illness receive this sacrament again. If during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious, the sacrament may be repeated as well. So if this applies to you or someone you know, please join us at this special Mass of healing and grace. Please arrive early so you can sign in and find your seats.

**\*\*Prayer Opportunities for healing of abuse victims and for renewal of the Church** On **September 15<sup>th</sup>**, the feast of **Our Lady of Sorrows**, all Catholic Churches in the Diocese of Erie will be open from 7am-7pm as invitation to everyone to stop by and say a prayer for the healing of victims and renewal in the church, for however long and in whatever manner you are inclined. Also, our Holy Hours of Eucharistic Adoration the next two months (September 17<sup>th</sup> and October 15<sup>th</sup>) will be offered for the specific intention for healing of victims of abuse (particularly those abused by members of the church) and for the renewal of the Catholic Church in all the diocese of Pennsylvania. I also repeat my offer to meet with you to discuss your concerns, hurts or struggles

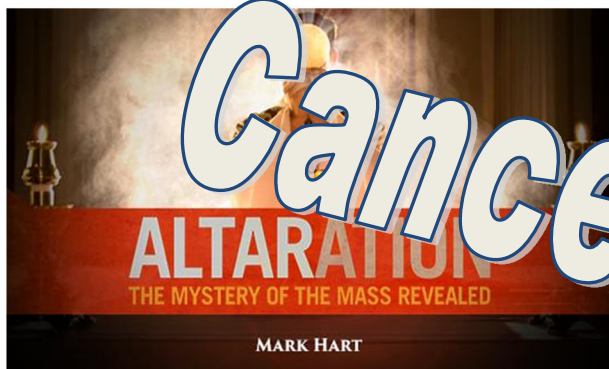
