We don't like it when we are brought up short by a prophetic voice that brings us some bad news about our own behavior. We don't like to be reproached for transgressions of the law or charged with violations of our training.

We may condemn and abuse those who bring us up against these truths about ourselves when, if we were really good, we would thank them for helping to keep us on the right path. This is the way they treated the prophets and the way they treated Jesus. Is this also the way we treat those whose message we don't like?

This Thursday, the Diocese of Erie will host a unique event called **"The 177 Project"** at St. Jude the Apostle Church. As they say on their website, "the 177 Project is an initiative from Adoration Artists designed to help spark a renewal in parishes across the country. We are firm believers in the power of spending time in front of the Eucharist and want to encourage that through a worshipful evening that fosters community within and across parishes. Over the course of three months, more than a dozen of the most talented artists in Catholic music will split up into teams of two and visit all 177 different dioceses within the US - including those in Alaska, Hawaii, and St. Thomas. Each evening will be centered around a Holy Hour. Upon conclusion of the Holy Hour, attendees will have the chance to enjoy a concert put on by the musicians traveling as part of the 177 Project. During the event, attendees will have opportunities for confession, to pray for others, to hear about the importance of (and even respond to) vocations, to say the rosary, to engage with local and national ministries, and to interact in a variety of other ways."

The Erie Event will take place at **St. Jude Church this Thursday, September 27th from 6:45-9pm**. And the national Catholic musicians who will lead worship and perform the concert will be Dave Moore and Lee Roessler. See the website for more information at www.the177project.com. Tickets are required and free but limited, so call the parish office to register.

It will be held at 12:30pm, on October 7th, in the parking lot in between the school and the church. This will be Fr. Kyle's first time to lead such a blessing as a priest so I know he is looking forward to it. All pets are welcome (as long as they are accompanied by an owner!).

****Wish List-FORMED, Catholic ON DEMAND**

I am very grateful to the generous donors who have paid for all 50 of the social room chairs that we asked for recently! As I mentioned last week, I have talked to our parish staff as well as our Faith Formation Committee, and we all agree that we would like to purchase a parish subscription to FORMED. FORMED is the revolutionary digital platform that would give us unprecedented access to video-based study programs, feature films, audio presentations, and eBooks from the Church's foremost presenters. It is the Catholic version of ON DEMAND that many of us have with our cable or internet providers and once we get a password for the parish, all parishioners could use the account on their computers and in their homes. The challenge is that we were not able to include FORMED in our 2018-19 budget and it costs \$1,850 per year for a parish. We have three donors who committed to one fourth of the cost so I would like to see if we have one additional donor who would be willing to cover the last quarter at \$450. This will be a valuable asset in our Religious Education and Faith Formation classes and will also allow us to empower our families to bring faith formation right into their homes. Let me know if you are interested in helping make this happen for OLP and I will let everyone know our login info once we are able to register.

****Part-time Communications Coordinator Needed**

We are looking to establish a new position on our staff in response to the Pastoral Council's recommendation last year. We are seeking a part time **Communications Coordinator** who will help oversee our social media communications as well as evaluating areas that we can grow in our effort to communicate our mission here at Our Lady of Peace more effectively. As recognized by the Pastoral Council, part of the new evangelization is meeting our people where they are and we know that more and more people (especially our younger generations) are in the world of social media. For this reason, this job will require expertise in social media and technology and some experience in communication will be helpful as well. Let me know if you would be interested or want to recommend someone for this position.

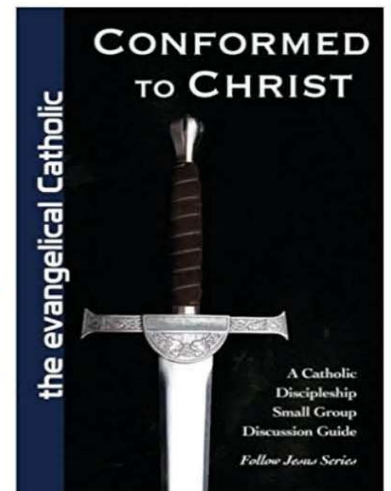

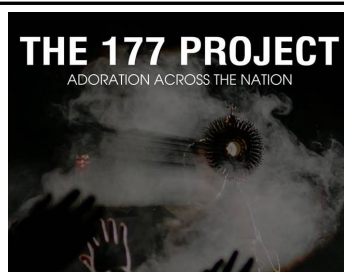

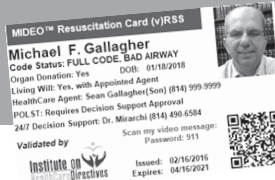
