From the Pastor's Desk...

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

This Sunday, October 7th, is Respect Life Sunday which kicks off Respect Life Month for the Catholic Church. The Catholic Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life Month to proclaim the immeasurable value of every person from conception to natural death. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops assists parishes, schools and other Catholic ministries by creating resources to help people "understand, value and become engaged with supporting the God-given dignity of every person — which naturally leads to protecting the gift of every person's life" through its Respect Life Program. The theme for the 2018-19 Respect Life Program is "Every Life: Cherished, Chosen, Sent" and highlights the call to build a culture of life as missionary disciples.

Here are a few opportunities in October to consider to help you enter into Respect Life Month.

1. Watch the **Canonization of St. Pope Paul VI and St. Oscar Romero on Sunday, October 14th on EWTN (3:30am and 12pm)**. St. Paul VI was a champion of the unborn and St. Oscar was a champion of the poor, two groups that are among the most vulnerable in our society today. Also take this opportunity to learn more about our 2 newest saints.
2. Join me in the **Annual Erie Rosary March on Sunday, October 14th at 2pm at St. Peter Cathedral** to pray for the intention that our government and society respect and protect all life. Immediately after the march there is adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Cathedral at which I will be the guest homilist. The entire event should be complete by 4pm or so.
3. Support and attend the **movie, "Gosnell", which will be released on October 12th** and portrays the arrest and trial of one of the worst abortionist doctors from Philadelphia in US History in 2011.

October is also the **month of the Rosary** since the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is today, October 7th. We are encouraged to respond to Pope Francis' invitation to recite the Rosary in the family, in the community and in parishes, for the Pope's intentions, for the Church's mission and for world peace by **praying the Rosary communally at 11:35am Monday through Friday, after the 8am Mass on Saturday and after the 7:30am Mass on Sundays (in the mother's chapel) during the month of October**. You are also encouraged to pray the Rosary privately if you cannot partake in these communal opportunities.

****Parish Registration Promotion** Our newly formed Welcome Committee is sponsoring a Parish Registration Promotion in October. There will be members of our committee at all Masses to help people officially register as members of Our Lady of Peace Parish.

Why register as a member of OLP? 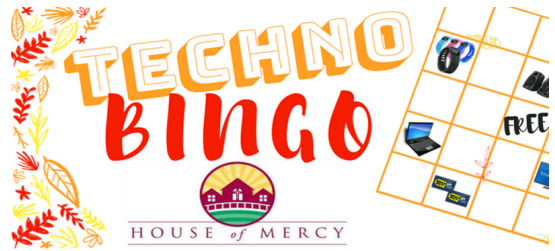

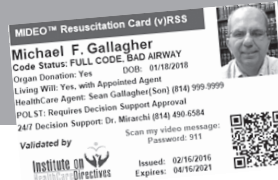


