**TOO MUCH INFORMATION!**

There is a common expression: "Too much information!" We usually use it when people tell us details about their lives that we don't want or need to know. Today, when James and John ask Jesus a simple question, making their request for places of honor in the kingdom, a simple answer might have been in order. Instead, as he often does, Jesus answers a question with a question; today it's about drinking the cup of suffering. Then, once the others are indignant over James and John's outrageous request, he proceeds to give them what may have been "too much information" for followers who were simply interested in the pursuit of glory. But this information, though it can sometimes seem "too much" for us, is essential for our lives as disciples. In Isaiah, in Hebrews, and in Mark today, we learn this information. It is in suffering, in weakness, in self-giving service to others, that we come to understand the kingdom. It is the information we need to find our place and come to be honored in the reign of God.

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

A blessed World Mission Sunday to you! In 1926 Pope Pius XI instituted Mission Sunday for the whole Church with the first worldwide Mission Sunday collection taking place in October 1927. The Mission Sunday collection is always taken on the next to last Sunday during the month of October. That day is celebrated in all the local Churches as the feast of catholicity and universal solidarity so Christians the world over will recognize their common responsibility with regard to the evangelization of the world. Today, with Catholics of the world, we are called to offer, at this Eucharistic celebration, our prayers and our generous financial support, through The Society for the Propagation of the Faith, to continue the mission of Jesus. Today we "speak up" through our prayers and personal sacrifices for our brothers and sisters in the Missions.

Even though Mission Sunday focuses on our prayerful and financial support of the missions to other parts of the world, we also know that we have a particular obligation to support the mission of our church right here at OLP. With that in mind, our parish encourages its parishioners to actively participate in the life of the church through our many ministries and activities. Although we all face pressure on our time, participating in one or more ministries is a good way to make the parish and faith a focal point of your life. With your help our parish will grow stronger and become even more vibrant, and will continue to serve the needs of our parish and the greater community.

With this purpose in mind, **our Pastoral Council is sponsoring a Parish Ministry Fair next weekend (October 27/28) after all the Masses.** Our hope is that you will purposefully pray this week about your potential involvement in a new ministry. The first step is openness and surrender to God's will and then come next week to learn more about our ministries and possibly sign up for involvement in one that is suited to your gifts. Or if you are not ready to sign up, take the information home with you and complete your discernment over the next few weeks and then respond if God is putting something on your heart.

The ministry fair is also a great way for us as a parish to celebrate what we do to continue the mission of Christ here at Our Lady of Peace and in our broader community. **Other notes from the pastor...**

**\*\*Women's Cursillo 253** I am away THIS weekend for a Women's Cursillo Retreat in Harborcreek. Please keep all those

who are a part of the retreat in your prayers (especially OLP parishioners Jean Verdecchia, Cindy Toland and Julie McLaughlin who are making the retreat for the first time) and know that you are in my prayers as well (as always!).

**\*\*All Saints Day Thursday, November 1<sup>st</sup> is the Solemn Feast of All Saints and Masse will be held at 7am, 9am (school Mass), 12:10pm and 7pm.** Come celebrate the witness and intercession of all saints who are the Church Triumphant. Recall that All Saints Day is one of our 6 holy days of obligation in the US (the others being the Immaculate Conception of Mary, December 8; Christmas, December 25; Mary Mother of God, January 1; the Ascension of the Lord, 40 days after Easter; and the Assumption of Mary, August 15). There are 10 holy days of obligation in the universal Latin Rite but the US church has transferred 2 to Sundays (the Epiphany and the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ=Corpus Christi) and petitioned the Holy See in 1991 to remove the obligation of 2 (the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, June 29 and the feast of St. Joseph, March 19) which the Vatican granted.

**\*\*All Soul's Day Masses and Memorial Prayer Service Friday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> is All Souls Day and we will have our regular daily Mass schedule of 7am and 12:10pm. Our Memorial Prayer Service for all those who have died this past year will be held at 7pm that night.** In a special part of the ceremony, we will remember and pray for all those whose funeral has been held at Our Lady of Peace since last November 2<sup>nd</sup>. We also will remember and pray for any of your loved ones who have died and had funerals elsewhere in that time period but you must contact us at the office to let us know who they are. See details elsewhere in the bulletin on how to do that.

**\*\*October- the month of the Rosary** We are encouraged to respond to Pope Francis' invitation to recite the Rosary in the family, in the community and in parishes, for the Pope's intentions, for the Church's mission and for world peace by **praying the Rosary communally at 11:35am Monday through Friday, after the 8am Mass on Saturday and after the 7:30am Mass on Sundays (in the mother's chapel) during the month of October.** You are also encouraged to pray the Rosary privately if you cannot partake in these communal opportunities.

**\*\*Parish Registration Promotion** Our newly formed Welcome Committee is sponsoring a Parish Registration Promotion on the first three Sundays of October. There will be members of our committee at all Masses to help people officially register as members of Our Lady of Peace Parish.

Why register as a member of OLP? Here are a few reasons to consider: ONE- registration is a way of committing to living out your Catholic faith in an intentional way through the mission of our parish through stewardship of your time, talent and treasure. It formally engages you in the financial support of our parish mission and also allows us to provide documentation of your financial support for tax purposes; TWO- registration is a concrete way to show you are actively practicing your faith and is required for those seeking to be Godparents or Sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation; THREE- registration will allow our new welcome committee to reach out to you and provide you information about our parish community and life; FOUR- registration allows you to receive all parish mailings and communication through email as well

**Online Safety Tips for Parents & Kids**

**DBullying Prevention Month:** Relational bullying is unwarranted, persistent, unwelcome behavior in the form criticism, isolation, or fabricated allegations that can damage relationships. Examples include social exclusion (You can't be with us"), spreading rumors (Did you hear...?), and withholding friendship (I won't be your friend if you..."). Though relational bullying can often seem ambiguous to outside observers and often garners less attention than physical bullying or verbal bullying, it should not be discounted simply as normal, adolescent behavior. In fact, several recent studies suggest relational bullying is more strongly related to emotional distress and teen depression than any other form of bullying. 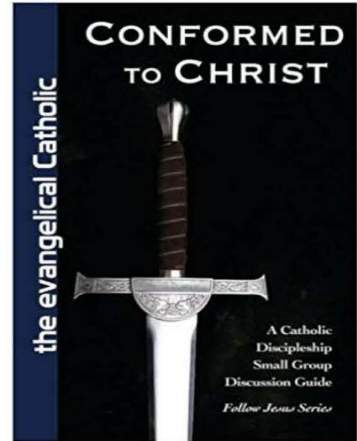


