Second Reading - It was not Christ who glorified himself, but rather the one who said to him: You are my son: this day I have begotten you (Hebrews 5:1-6).

Gospel - Immediately the blind man received his sight and followed Jesus on the way (Mark 10:46-52).

THE HOPE AND PROMISE OF REDEMPTION

The prophet Jeremiah prophesies the end of the Babylonian exile. He describes how the weak and sorrowful people now return with joy. These are the scattered people of God: the blind and the lame, the mothers and pregnant women. They shall be led along an easy road so that no one will stumble. The Lord's kindness and mercy are on all these weak and broken people.

Here and in Psalm 126 we find the most lovely poetic images of God's love and care for us. "Those that sow in tears / shall reap rejoicing. Although they go forth weeping, / carrying the seed to be sown, / they shall come back rejoicing, / carrying their sheaves" (Psalm 126:5-6). Although God had to punish Israel for their many sins, God never forgot them, scattered as they were, and brings them all back to the land of their ancestors, there to flourish and be joyful again. We can see in this the hope and the promise of our own redemption, gathered from the far corners of the earth into the great banquet of God.

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

Thank you to everyone who supported and prayed for the Women's Cursillo Retreat last weekend in which I participated. It was a grace-filled weekend with 16 candidates (3 from OLP), 12 team members, and many volunteers, and the Holy Spirit moved powerfully among all those who were involved. I continue to believe that our diocesan retreats- Cursillo, Divine Mercy Encounter (DME) and Marriage Encounter- are great instruments of the Holy Spirit of which I would like to see our parish community take advantage and participate. The next **Cursillo's are Men's- November 15-18, 2018 and Women's- March 16-19, 2109- both at Our Lady of Mercy Parish in Harborcreek.**

The next DME is **November 9-11, 2018, at St. Joseph/ Bread of Life Community in Erie and I, along with several other OLP Parishioners, will be on the team** (so I REALLY hope some of you will be a part of this!). I know I just did the Cursillo and I do not like to be away from OLP two weekends in a little under a month but I committed to Cursillo a year ago and this is the only DME I could work through 2019 and so I decided to power through now since I will not be working either for over a year. I hope you understand.

For World Wide Marriage Encounter, right now the Diocese of Erie supports the retreats in Pittsburgh but the schedule for 2019 is not available yet and the last retreat for 2018 was this weekend. Keep an eye on the website for updates: <http://www.wmme.org/>

On another note, this is a big week in our Liturgical Year with All Saints Day and All Souls Day. See below for more information on these important feasts but I remind you to write the names of your loved ones who have died in our **book of remembrance** that can be found in the vestibule. Recall that it will be brought into the sanctuary on All Souls Day to signify all those who we pray for in a special way at all Masses that day as well as throughout the entire month of November.

****Parish Ministry Fair** Our Pastoral Council is sponsoring a **Parish Ministry Fair THIS weekend (October 27/28) after all the Masses.** There will be tables set up in the gym representing most of our ministries. There will also be some refreshments available. If you are not ready to sign up, take the information home with you and complete your discernment over the next few weeks and then respond if God is putting something on your heart. The ministry fair is also a great way for us as a parish to celebrate what we do to continue the mission of Christ here at Our Lady of Peace and in our broader community. I sincerely thank everyone who has been or is

still involved in these great ministries in our parish. May God bless our parish ministries and all those involved for their generosity!

****All Hallow's Eve (Halloween)** Fr. Kyle and I will again be giving out candy on Halloween Night (Wednesday, October 31st) from 6-8pm at the rectory (left or east of the parish office door). We would love to see your costumes and offer you a treat in gratitude for all that you and our parish family do for us!

****All Saints Day** **Thursday, November 1st is the Solemn Feast of All Saints and Masse will be held at 7am, 9am (school Mass), 12:10pm and 7pm.** Come celebrate the witness and intercession of all saints who are the Church Triumphant. Recall that All Saints Day is one of our 6 holy days of obligation in the US (the others being the Immaculate Conception of Mary, December 8; Christmas, December 25; Mary Mother of God, January 1; the Ascension of the Lord, 40 days after Easter; and the Assumption of Mary, August 15). There are 10 holy days of obligation in the universal Latin Rite but the US church has transferred 2 to Sundays (the Epiphany and the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ -Corpus Christi) and petitioned the Holy See in 1991 to remove the obligation of 2 (the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, June 29 and the feast of St. Joseph, March 19) which the Vatican granted.

****All Soul's Day Masses and Memorial Prayer Service** **Friday, November 2nd is All Souls Day and we will have our regular daily Mass schedule of 7am and 12:10pm. Our Memorial Prayer Service for all those who have died this past year will be held at 7pm that night.** In a special part of the ceremony, we will remember and pray for all those whose funeral has been held at Our Lady of Peace since last November 2nd. We also will remember and pray for any of your loved ones who have died and had funerals elsewhere in that time period but you must contact us at the office to let us know who they are. 
