TIME

The holidays are well behind us; the year stretches out ahead. And what sort of year will it be? To judge by the words of Jesus in today's Gospel, it will be "a year acceptable to the Lord." And Jesus surely didn't mean only the next three hundred sixty-five days facing his listeners at that time.

When Jesus announced the "arrival" of God's favor, it was a message for all time, for every year. Similarly, we read today in Nehemiah how the people gathered with solemnity to hear God's word as though for the first time. They listened, and then fell to the ground and wept. But the prophet said, "Today is holy . . . do not be sad, and do not weep."

The "year acceptable to the Lord" is this year. The day that is "holy" is this day. The time to listen is now. What sort of year will you have? What sort of day? God's help is always here. What you do with each day can be holy and acceptable to the Lord if you but listen to and act on God's word.

***Blessing of Throats** Next weekend we will offer the traditional blessing of throats associated with the Feast of St. Blaise on February 3rd. So at the end of all Masses a general blessing will be offered and then after Mass there will be an opportunity for individual throat blessings.

****"Night to Shine"** We are excited that OLP is the sponsoring church for "Night to Shine" (NTS) which will be held **Friday, February 9th from 6-9pm at Union Station in Erie**. NTS is a prom night experience that celebrates people 14 and older with special needs. Red carpet welcome with paparazzi, dinner, photos, dancing, crowning ceremony for our guests along with a separate gathering for the caregivers all take place simultaneously at over 600 churches (locations) worldwide! ****Community Gatherings Coming Soon** Once again I received a lot of great feedback on the Appreciation Dinner we had last weekend. One of the main comments was how great it was to gather with others in the parish and reconnect with old friends or to meet new ones. We have two more opportunities for this same type of community building in the next two months. We will have



our annual **Mardi Gras Party on Tuesday, March 5th from 6-8pm**. And our **St. Joseph Table (which we have celebrated the last four years) will take place on Tuesday, March 19th after a 5:30pm Mass for the feast of St. Joseph**. Keep an eye out in the bulletin in the coming weeks for more information on both Mardi Gras and the St. Joseph Table in the next month. Mark your calendars and be a part of strengthening our parish family's bond.

****Holy Land Pilgrimage** I will lead a pilgrimage to the Holy Land of Israel from **October 26-November 5, 2019**. Cost is \$4,299 per person and will include 1 night in Tel Aviv, 2 nights in Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee, and 6 nights in Jerusalem with airfare, hotels, and breakfast and dinner each day (lunch is not included). Highlights will include Nazareth, the Jordan River, Bethlehem, and Jerusalem. See the actual locations of almost all of the mysteries of the Rosary: **JOYFUL-** the Annunciation, Visitation, Nativity, the Presentation and Finding in the Temple; **LUMINOUS-** the Baptism of the Lord, the Wedding Feast of Cana, the Proclamation of the Kingdom (Mt. of Beatitudes), Transfiguration and the Last Supper; All the **SORROWFUL** on the Via Dolorosa; and 4 of the 5 **GLORIOUS-** Resurrection, Ascension, Pentecost, and Assumption (we will only not get to see the location of the Coronation of Mary since it happened in Heaven!). Believe me when I say that if you go you will never read the Bible or pray the Rosary the same again! Online Safety Tips for Parents & Kids

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments - Human Trafficking and Protecting our Youth: Trafficking of youth is a form of modern slavery. It includes both sex trafficking and forced labor. Any child under age 18 engaged in commercial sex is a victim of sex trafficking, even if the youth's participation is not forced or coerced. Be aware of recruiting tactics. Traffickers target victims through social media sites, telephone chat lines, afterschool programs, at shopping malls, bus depots, clubs/bars or through friends and acquaintances. To help protect your child, ask questions about your child's friends, monitor their computer use and know where he/she hangs out.
