**From the Pastor's Desk...**

To my Spiritual Family of Our Lady of Peace-

A blessed Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ to you! (also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ"). This feast originated in France in the mid-thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. It was instituted by the Pope in response to much debate in the church in the early part of the 2<sup>nd</sup> millennium about the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. This is a good opportunity for us to review and reinforce our belief in this incredible mystery of faith that is the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ!

So a few things to review- the Real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist raises the Eucharist above all other sacraments. We call it "Real" not to diminish the presence of Christ in other ways (the Word, the sacraments, each other through our baptism, in the poor and needy, etc) but because it is the fullest sense, the SUBSTANTIAL SENSE of His presence. The church explains how this mystery occurs through the word TRANSUBSTANTIATION which is defined as a change of the whole substance of the bread into the substance of the body of Christ our Lord and of the whole substance of the wine into the substance of the blood. The substance of the bread and wine (the form of a thing, like our soul) changes while the accidents (visible characteristics) remain the same. The church also explains that the Eucharistic presence begins at the moment of Consecration (during Mass at the words of institution from the Last Supper) and endures as long as the Eucharistic Species subsists and that breaking the Body of Christ does not diminish the Real Presence.

The Church has come to this understanding of the Real Presence through Revelation- God has revealed it to us through Jesus, the Sacred Scriptures AND Sacred Tradition. The most clear explanation of this truth can be found in the Bread of Life Discourse of Jesus in the 6 chapter of John's Gospel where Jesus proclaims that the Bread of Life is "real flesh and real blood."

So what is our response? We recall that the Eucharist cannot be apprehended by the senses or by our intellect alone and that ONLY AN ASSENT OF FAITH in divine authority is an appropriate response. We assent to the mystery because this is what Jesus has revealed to us himself, through His Spirit and the church. That is why our "AMEN" at the moment we receive Holy Communion is so important. We are saying "AMEN" or "so be it" or "I believe" that this is TRULY the Body and Blood of Christ being presented to me! So let your AMEN be a little more vigorous on this feast. Let yourself be awed as the God of the Universe humbles himself and comes to you in this amazing, glorious way.

May God bless our week ahead!

Welcome to Fr. Mark as he started his assignment here at OLP as Parochial Vicar last week! Please make sure to give him a warm OLP welcome. Father Mark Hoffman is a native son of Our Lady of Peace Parish. He was born in Erie on July 6, 1959, the son of Edward and Rina (Amatangelo) Hoffman. He was baptized at Saint Paul Parish and lived in "little Italy" the first 9 years of his life, attending Saint Paul School thru 3rd grade. In 1968 his family moved to Millcreek and joined Our Lady of Peace Parish. Father Hoffman is the eldest of three sons. His middle brother is Edward Jr., and his youngest is John. All three attended Our Lady of Peace Parish. Edward is now retired military, and John is employed at WTAE-TV in Pittsburgh.

Father graduated from OLP School in 1973, Cathedral Preparatory School in 1977, and Gannon University in 1982.

In 1984, Father Hoffman entered Saint Mark Seminary in Erie, in the fall of 1985, he entered Saint Vincent Seminary, Latrobe PA. He was ordained a transitional deacon on October 15, 1989. and a priest on April 27, 1990, at Saint Peter Cathedral by Bishop Michael J. Murphy.

His priestly assignments include parochial vicar, teacher at Cathedral Prep, Bradford Central Christian and Elk County Christian High Schools. Father was also the Director of Vocations for the Diocese of Erie, Assistant Master of Ceremonies for the Bishop, and Catholic Chaplain at Allegheny and Grove City Colleges. Father has been a pastor for several parishes in the diocese of Erie, including Saint Mary of Grace - Meadville, Church of the Beloved Disciple - Grove City, Saint Jude- Erie, Saint Thomas - Corry, and Saint Mark/Mt. Calvary - Erie.

Father Hoffman is joining us from Notre Dame Parish in Hermitage, as temporary parochial vicar on a 1-year assignment. Father Hoffman is excited to be returning to where it all began, Our Lady of Peace Parish. He brings with him a depth of experiences and is eager to assist me in the work of the Gospel and service to our people.

**\*\*Fortnight for Freedom** The Fortnight for Freedom is from June 21—the vigil of the Feasts of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More—to July 4, Independence Day. Since 2010, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have encouraged dioceses around the country to highlight the importance of defending religious freedom as we approach Independence Day. “Religion [cannot] be relegated to the inner sanctum of personal life, without influence on societal and national life.” -Pope Francis, *Evangelii Gaudium*, 183. If religious liberty is not respected, all people suffer and are deprived of the essential contribution to the common good, be it in education, health care, feeding the hungry, civil rights, and social services that the Church and other people of faith make every day, both here at home and overseas. This will be a special intention at our daily Masses during this stretch and I encourage you to find ways to incorporate this intention in your daily prayers. Also, our daily parish rosary at 11:35AM will include this intention. 


