

SEEKING THE LIGHT

In today's readings we find ourselves being drawn more deeply into relationship with Jesus. We are getting to know more about him as we see how he struggles with the news of his cousin John's arrest. His first response is to withdraw, to leave Nazareth and go to Capernaum. There he is perhaps both consoled and challenged by the words of Isaiah that Matthew quotes: "the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light, / on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death / light has arisen" (Matthew 4:16). Jesus contemplates his cousin's death, perhaps his own death, and he seeks the light. Maybe it is these words of Isaiah that move Jesus out of his withdrawal and into action. - **Divine Mercy Encounter Retreat (DME) I will be away next weekend (January 3 I-February 2) as part of the DME weekend. I thank Fr. Hoffman and Fr. Shane for covering things at OLP in my absence. Please keep all those participating in the retreat in your prayers this weekend- that we all may be renewed in the amazing love and mercy of our God. And know that I will be praying for you in a special way!
- **The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is February 2nd so it will be celebrated at all the Masses throughout the universal Catholic Church next weekend. Recall that it is the 4th Joyful Mystery of the Rosary that recalls the moment Jesus was presented to God at the temple 40 days after his birth. One tradition with this feast is the blessing of candles (it used to be called Candlemas). So at the 11AM Mass next weekend we will bless our liturgical and votive candles and have a candle procession at the beginning of the Mass to celebrate Jesus as the light of the world.
- **St. Blaise Throat Blessings Monday, February 3rd is the Feast of St. Blaise. So next weekend (February 1/2) we will offer

throat blessings after all Masses in anticipation of the feast.

- **Tabernacle and Crown Restoration Part of our Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) Parish Project for 2020 is restoring the Tabernacle and Crown from the main sanctuary of the church. We want to have them completed for Easter (April 12th) so they have been taken by A.T. Merhaut for that purpose. In it's place we have the Tabernacle that we use to repose the Blessed Sacrament on Holy Thursday in the School Cafeteria for our main tabernacle in the church.
- **Holy Land Pilgrimage Presentation There will be a presentation about the Holy Land Pilgrimage that we took back in the Fall of 2019 on Thursday, February 6th at 7:PM in the school

cafeteria. It will include a slide show, commentary, time for questions as well as refreshments. I hope you can join us so we can allow our journey to be a source of grace for you.

- **Parish Census Update So far over 1,000 census forms have been returned. Over 1,200 were mailed last month so whatever you can do to help us get the others returned would be greatly appreciated. Follow up Calls will be made in the next few weeks and we would like to minimize the amount of calls needed. Volunteers are needed to make phone calls.
- **Mom's Funeral I want to take this moment to profusely thank you, my parish family of Our Lady of Peace, for the overwhelming support and prayer you offered to me and my family earlier this month as we dealt with the sudden death of my mom. Mary Ann Toohey died on Saturday, January 4th and the funeral was at St. George Church (my home parish) on Wednesday, January 8th. Mom's death, the viewing and visitation at the funeral home, and the funeral Mass were difficult yet incredibly grace-filled days for me and my family. And I know your prayers and the Holy Spirit were the source of that grace.

Directly dealing with death of a loved one forces us to confront the reality that God did not create us to live here on earth forever. Then we have a choice to strengthen our belief in the birth, life, passion, death and resurrection of Jesus that opened to us the way to eternal life with God for which God has created us or to despair and wallow in unbelief and our loss. I choose to believe and allow the Holy Spirit to bear the fruit of peace, joy and love in my heart and life. Your prayers and love help me to make that choice. I pray that you can choose to believe and love through your crosses and deaths as well.




