



A FORETASTE OF PARADISE

Throughout Easter Time, the Church rejoices with Jesus, risen from the dead. Our readings on this Fourth Sunday of Easter celebrate our instinct to come together in joy, worshipping in church. While private prayer nourishes our individual relationship with the Lord, community prayer is a foretaste of paradise. The book of Revelation depicts a "great multitude" worshipping God "day and night in his temple." Our churches on Easter Sunday often reflect this happy multitude, filling the pews to bursting. Four Sundays into the festive season, we are encouraged to keep praising God together. In the Acts of the Apostles, Paul and Barnabas demonstrate their instinct to worship with their faith community each Sabbath, dutifully taking their seats in the synagogue. In the Gospel, Jesus calls us his sheep and reminds us why coming together as a flock is so important: uniting in community, we imitate the unity of God.

****World Day of Prayer for Vocations and Holy Hour**

This Sunday, May 8th is the 4th Sunday of Easter and the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. We will pray for all young people in our parish and diocesan church to be open to God's call for them... to priesthood, diaconate, religious life, devoted single life and married life. There will be a **Holy Hour for vocations on Monday, May 9th at 7pm.**

****Special Masses this Week** Monday, May 9th- Easter Weekday; Tuesday, May 10th- St. Damien of Vuester, Priest (19th Century Belgian priest who eventually went to the Hawaiian Island of Molokai to minister to lepers and died of the disease at 49 years old); Wednesday, May 11th- Easter Weekday; Thursday, May 12th- Sts. Nereus and Achilleus, Martyrs (1st Century Roman Soldiers who converted to Christianity); Friday, May 13th- Our Lady of Fatima; Saturday, May 14th- St. Matthias, Apostle.

****The 45th Anniversary of the Dedication of Our Lady of Peace Church is Sunday, May 15th but since it falls on a Sunday, we will be celebrating the anniversary liturgically at our Masses on Monday, May 16th.** We will pray for all the living and deceased members of OLP Parish as well as the clergy, religious and benefactors who all helped build our church building in 1976-77.

****Our next Anointing of the Sick Mass will be Saturday, May 14th at 5pm.** If you or someone you know could benefit from this Sacrament please plan to come and/or bring them to Mass. If you are suffering from a serious illness or condition (physical, mental, emotional), are frail due to age, have recovered from a serious condition but relapsed, are expecting major surgery, are terminally ill or actively dying, you may receive this tangible source of grace and strength. Remember that you can receive the anointing more than once and that it is not just reserved for "Last Rites."

****OLP Faithful to the Finish 5K and Parish Endowment**

Part of our mission at Our Lady of Peace is to ensure that the Christian way of life continues not just in our generation, but for generations to come. One new way we can do that is by supporting our Parish Endowment established with the Catholic Foundation of Northwest PA. Baby Bottle Fundraiser:

The **Our Lady of Peace Knights of Columbus** have joined all the Erie and Crawford County councils to conduct a **Baby Bottle** fundraising drive to benefit the **Women's Care Center of Erie** in their goal of purchasing a **mobile ultrasound van**. This medically equipped vehicle will visit rural areas, as well as our five local universities to provide valuable lifesaving services.

In 2021, the KofC provided an ultrasound machine to the Care Center, and in less than a year 63 previously abortion bound women chose life for their unborn children, after viewing them on this state of the art machine. While this is certainly an achievement, we are now focusing on helping to raise \$250,000 to purchase a **mobile ultrasound van**. If the KofC along with other entities are able to achieve this goal, the KofC Supreme council in Connecticut will pay the entire cost of the mobile ultrasound machine, (around \$45,000).

Baby bottles will be distributed as you leave church on Mother's Day. If you are able, we ask that you fill them with change, currency or checks (made out to OLP Knights of Columbus) and return them on Father's Day.
