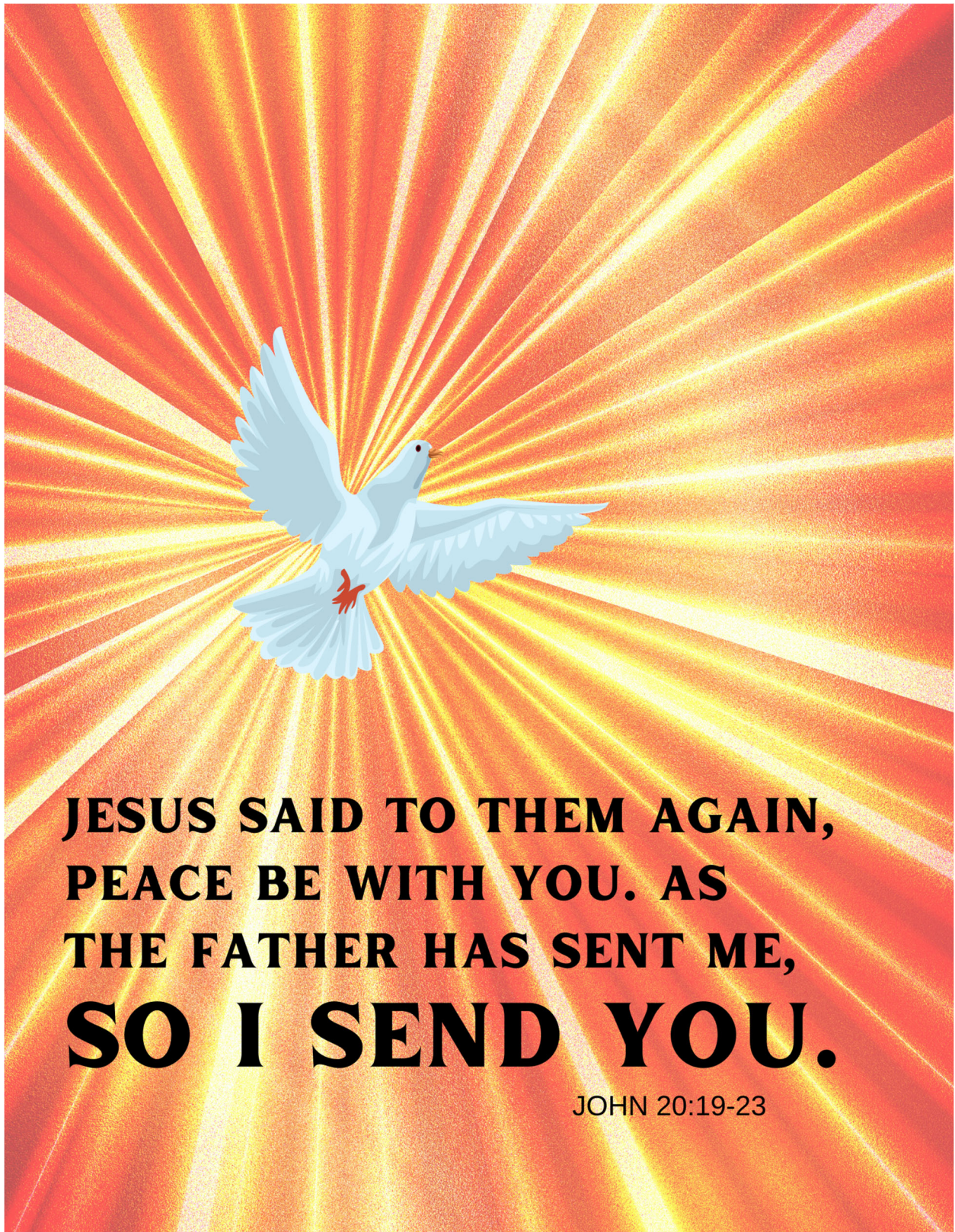

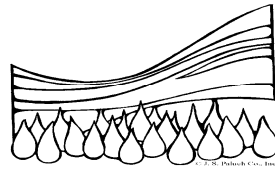

Family Discussion of the Week: Gifts for Service

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord. (1 Cor. 12:4-5)

Adults: What gift of service have you received from the Holy Spirit and how well are you using it right now?

Kids: What gift do you hope to receive from the Holy Spirit? How could you use it to serve others?

THE SPIRIT'S ACTIVE POWER

The mystery of the Trinity refers to one God in three persons. We frequently acknowledge Jesus as "the second person of the Trinity," but referring also to the Spirit as a "person" comes less naturally. In religious art, the Holy Spirit often appears as a dove or, as in today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, tongues of fire. Much rarer are images of the Spirit as a "person" in recognizable human form. Today's readings do not settle the issue of how to picture the Spirit, but they certainly give shape to the Spirit's active power in the world and in each human heart. In Acts, the Spirit enables people to speak and understand a variety of languages. Paul's letter to the Corinthians praises the Spirit for all kinds of spiritual gifts, services, and "workings." Finally, in John's Gospel, Jesus calls the Spirit our Advocate and our divine teacher.

From the Pastor's Desk...

Happy Birthday Church of God! The Solemnity of Pentecost is unofficially considered the birthday of the Church and officially concludes the Easter Season. We wear Red this weekend (for all Masses of the Holy Spirit) to reinforce our desire for the Holy Spirit to renew His power and inspiration in our parish and in our individual lives. Also, we will have **exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after the 4:30pm Mass (around 5:15pm) until 6pm at which time we will celebrate Solemn Evening Prayer and Benediction to conclude the Easter Season.** There will be birthday cake for all those who attend because that's what you do as a family when celebrating a birthday, right??

There are two specific movements of the Holy Spirit at Our Lady of Peace that I am excited about this week. One movement of the Holy Spirit is our participation in a national movement called "Amazing Parish." Members of the new Faith Formation Team for the Diocese of Erie are implementing the Amazing Parish model in their approach to leading the diocese and they have encouraged parishes in the Diocese to consider following their lead. They approached me to consider this process for our parish and after prayer and discernment I have decided that I feel strongly that this is where God is calling our spiritual community. So the first step they identify is to create a Parish Leadership Team (PLT). This is not the staff or pastoral council, but a small group that helps lead the parish with the pastor in overseeing the spiritual and organizational health of the parish. I have identified the following members of our parish for our PLT at OLP- Gina Adams, Warren Beaver, Justin Miles, Mary Beth Whitman, and myself. This team will be attending the Amazing Parish Summit in Denver this week (June 6-8) and seeking to implement what we learn upon our return. Please pray for this team this week in a special way that we can be open to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in leading our parish community forward into new life and purpose.

The second movement of the Holy Spirit evidenced at OLP this week is the new priestly ministry of Fr. Chris Wheeler who was ordained with his classmates on May 27th. Fr. Chris had a week away immediately after ordination but will be living with us and helping with Mass and Confession coverage until his new assignment begins in July. **Fr. Chris' official Mass of Thanksgiving at OLP will be NEXT SUNDAY, JUNE 12th at the 9am Mass.** There will be a light reception right after Mass in the main outside entryway of the church. Please join us for this special Mass as an opportunity to thank God for Fr. Chris' vocation to serve the church of the Diocese of Erie and to thank Fr. Chris for his presence and ministry at OLP over the last two years.

May God bless our new Parish Leadership Team, newly ordained Fr. Chris Wheeler and our week ahead!

****Feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church- Monday, June 6th**

In 2018 the Office of Divine Worship confirmed the decision of Pope Francis to celebrate this special feast the Monday after Pentecost every year. It is appropriate that Mary's presence with the apostles on Pentecost as she helped give birth to the Church as the Mystical Body of Christ be recognized with a special feast the day after Pentecost. The Order of Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours and Celebration of the Eucharist (often called the Ordo) says it this way... "The joyous veneration given to the Mother of God by the contemporary Church, in light of reflection on the mystery of Christ and on his nature, cannot ignore the figure of a woman (cf. Gal. 4:4), the Virgin Mary, who is both Mother of Christ and Mother of the Church."

Year One will focus on the Diocese, Year 2 on the parish and Year 3 on the Catholic Church on a national level (highlighted by a Eucharistic Congress). Please plan on joining us June 19.

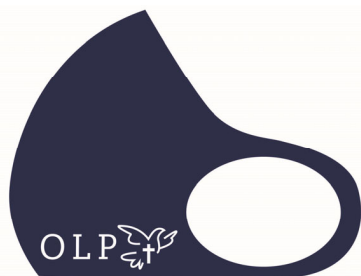
