



Family Discussion of the Week: The Spirit of Truth

Jesus said, "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own, but will speak whatever he hears, and he will declare to you the things that are to come." (John 16:12-13a)

Adults: In what difficult situation has the Holy Spirit helped you see more clearly? Kids: What kind of decision can the Holy Spirit help you with?

BIBLICAL ROOTS OF THE TRINITY

Today's readings show some biblical roots of what Christians would later call the Trinity. Proverbs showcases the role of Wisdom in the work of creation, portrayed as a reality outside of God but integrated into God's work of forming the heavens and the earth. We join the psalmist in sharing Wisdom's delight in God's handiwork: "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth" (Psalm 8:2). In his letter to the Romans, Paul writes of peace with God through Jesus, and the love of God received through the Holy Spirit, distinguishing God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit while also displaying their abiding unity. Finally, in the farewell discourse from John's Gospel, Jesus-who had earlier spoken of himself as Son of the Father-promises his friends that they will receive the Spirit of truth that will teach and guide them after his departure. From the Pastor's Desk...

A blessed Trinity Sunday to you! I share with you parts of an article from the Erie Diocesan Communications Office announcing the start of a three year initiative from the US Bishops on Eucharistic Renewal. "Catholics throughout the United States are invited to participate in a three-year journey to the "source and summit" (CCC§1034) of the Catholic faith — a Eucharistic Revival — planned to awaken the faithful to the truth and beauty of the Holy Eucharist. "It's an invitation to every institution, every family, parish and school to inflame again a relationship with the Lord and the Eucharist," says Father Matt Kujawinski, administrator of the Office of Divine Worship of the Diocese of Erie. The revival was prompted in part by a well-known Pew Research Center report published in 2019 that indicated that approximately two-thirds of American Catholics do not believe that the Eucharist is the real presence of Jesus Christ. Despite some concerns about design flaws in the survey, the data indicates that the number of Catholics disengaged from the heart of Catholicism is of epic proportion. "When you see that so many Catholics do not believe in the real presence, it goes right back to our formation," says Bishop Lawrence Persico. "If we were properly formed, then we would understand that the church has always taught that at the Mass, the bread and wine become the real body and blood of Christ. It's unfortunate that so many people just think it's symbolic. Jesus said, 'This is my body, this is my blood.' And we as a matter of faith, believe those words. The Eucharist is the actual presence of Christ." "Christ is present to us in a very real way in the Eucharist. It is a great gift that he has given us. The night before he died, he gave us himself to be with us always. Any time we attend Mass and receive the Eucharist, we are receiving that gift. Every time we celebrate Mass, we renew that relationship with Christ," Bishop Persico added.

Bishops in the United States began making plans to address this fundamental issue in a substantive way just prior to the pandemic. The lack of ability to receive the Eucharist intensified the fervor of many Catholics. The fact that for others it exacerbated their indifference to the sacrament, highlighted the urgent need for catechesis. The three-year revival begins on June 19 with Eucharistic processions in dioceses across the country. In these traditional expressions of faith, the Blessed Sacrament leads the procession and is carried under a canopy consistent with the way the Lord traveled in the Ark of the Covenant when carried by the people of Israel. "The canopy is a sign that the Lord is present," says Father Kujawinski. "The people follow behind, just as we follow the Lord. It is a microcosm of our faith. Accompanied by music, it is clearly a cause for celebration." Bishop Persico highlights the importance of gathering. "It's about community," he says. "We are a church; we are not just individuals. We are members of the body of Christ. When we come together for a procession, it's a sign of our faith in the Eucharist. As a church, we gather around our risen Lord to participate and to proclaim to others that this is Christ, and we worship him." Father Kujawinski adds, "Oftentimes, through familiarity, we take things for granted. This three-year period is an opportunity to renew our belief in the Eucharist and what this great gift means for us. It is obvious that, as Catholics, we need a revival to inspire us to relearn, rediscover and plunge deeper into the mystery of the Lord's presence."

Because the Diocese of Erie is geographically vast, processions will be offered by St. Peter Cathedral, Erie; Notre Dame Parish, Hermitage; St. Catherine of Siena Parish, DuBois and St. Bernard Parish, Bradford, on June 19. Each will begin at 1:00PM rain or shine."

May God bless our upcoming Eucharistic Revival and our week ahead!

- **New Assignments for Priests Bishop Persico has announced the following assignments to take effect on July 6, 2022. Fr. Mark Hoffman will be the new pastor at Our Lady of the Lake in Edinboro as well as providing sacramental ministry at Edinboro University. Fr. Chris Wheeler will be the assistant pastor for a cluster of parishes in Port Allegheny, Coudersport and Galeton. The new parochial vicar/assistant pastor at OLP will be Fr. David Whiteford who is native son of St. Boniface and was ordained in 2017. Fr. David has been teaching at DuBois Central Catholic School while residing in Brockway over the past 5 years. There are a total of 24 priests being assigned to new places so we pray for OLP and all the parishes effected by these moves. We will have a chance to thank Fr. Mark and Fr. Chris over the next month but please keep them in your prayers in this time of transition.

**Total Tune Up Fair The last TTUF is Monday, June 13th at Blessed Sacrament. The event is from 9:30am to 12pm followed by a lunch. Those who attend will get clarity on their legal and financial concerns, health issues like confusing medications, and dental questions. There will be assessments for fitness, balance and blood pressure as well as COVID boosters and more. There will be presentations on taxes, increased income, improved distribution options, living wills, estate and funeral planning. Stop by the parish office to pick up a ticket for this event. A freewill offering can be made for the ticket which is valued at \$20.

**One movement of the Holy Spirit at OLP is our participation in a national movement called "Amazing Parish." Members of the new Faith Formation Team for the Diocese of Erie are implementing the Amazing Parish model in their approach to leading the diocese and they have encouraged parishes in the Diocese to consider following their lead. They approached me to consider this process for our parish and after prayer and discernment I have decided that I feel strongly that this is where God is calling our spiritual community. So the first step they identify is to create a Parish Leadership Team (PLT). This is not the staff or pastoral council, but a small group that helps lead the parish with the pastor in overseeing the spiritual and organizational health of the parish. I have identified the following members of our parish for our PLT at OLP- Gina Adams, Warren Beaver, Justin Miles, Mary Beth Whitman, and myself. This team attended the Amazing Parish Summit in Denver last week (June 6-8) and will seek to implement what was learned. Please pray for the team in a special way that we can be open to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in leading our parish community forward into new life and purpose.

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments - Listen - This summer, when children are out of school, meeting new people and going to new places, make sure that you talk to them often about their experiences and the people they've met. Listen carefully to your children. If possible, observe and get to know the other children and adults who are part of your children's summertime fun. Above all, communicate your safety concerns to your children. Make sure your children know they can come to you with any concerns they may have about the people they interact with. And if you hear of or observe behaviors that may be inappropriate, make sure to communicate your feelings to people who are in a position to intervene.
