**Family Discussion of the Week: Acting With Mercy**

But a Samaritan while traveling came near him; and when he saw him, he was moved with pity. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, having poured oil and wine on them. Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. (Luke 10:33-34)

**Adults:** When have you gone out of your way to help a stranger in need?

**Kids:** Would you help a new student who needed help? Why or why not?

**RIGHT RELATIONSHIPS**

Our God is about relationships. In the first reading, Moses reminds the Israelites that the laws, which are already in their hearts, keep them in right relationship with the God who loves them so much that they always find forgiveness. Centuries later, along comes Jesus, whom Paul describes to the Colossians as "the image of the invisible God," the very embodiment of this God of love. In his parable about the good Samaritan, Jesus explains how the law of love overrules the letter of the law. Instead of answering the question "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus demonstrates that it is not about who is worthy of being loved, but rather loving as God loves—about *being* neighbor, about being the good Samaritan. Jesus wants us to continue his work as images of this God of love by loving *all* people, even those who seem to be our enemies.

**\*\*Feast of Our Lady of Peace** There is no universal feast day for Our Lady of Peace on the Roman Catholic Liturgical Calendar. But Saturday, July 9<sup>th</sup> is one of two dates celebrated by a few diocese throughout the country for Mary under this title (the other being January 24<sup>th</sup>). So the Liturgy Committee and Staff have decided that we will celebrate our parish feast day on that date annually since we have never had a patronal feast day at OLP. Mass in the morning at 8am will be the votive Mass for Mary, Queen of Peace, and we will have cake at the bonfire in the evening to recognize that. Hopefully we can build on this and make this feast more prominent in the years to come.

**\*\*Overturning Roe vs. Wade and TRUE FREEDOM** I praise and thank God for the recent Supreme Court decision in overturning Roe Vs. Wade so that abortion is no longer protected on a federal level in our country but left to the States to legislate. I also pray for any protests to this to be peaceful and for no destructive or violent responses in our community and country.

It is interesting to me to see the evolution of the pro-abortion argument over the last 50 years. At first it was an argument that the life in the womb was not human. As science refuted that argument, the focus turned to the law and freedom. Now the law has been taken away, so now the entire focus is on freedom (where the pro-choice label comes from). But that argument fails to understand that true freedom is the freedom to choose what is right and good and holy and NOT just the ability to choose whatever one wants. The pro-abortion argument says that the freedom of a mother is greater than the life of the child in the womb, and we as Catholics can never agree to this. Jesus told us that the greatest love that one can have is to give one's life for the life of a friend, it is not acceptable for us to say I choose to take your life for mine. So let us pray that our country can understand and embrace this proper understanding of freedom and how it applies to this issue of the unborn.

Taking the discussion of freedom even further, as Catholics, we celebrate freedom at every Mass. It is the greatest freedom Jesus won for us on the Cross, that is freedom from sin and death (the ONLY things that can separate us from the love of God). So as we join our country in being grateful for our legal freedoms that she is founded on, let's make sure to not forget to be grateful for the spiritual freedoms that are even more important from the eternal perspective.

With all this in mind, this prayer of thanksgiving and prayer for peace and protection in response to the Dobbs Supreme Court decision, as well as a proper understanding of freedom and religious liberty, will all be a continued part of our daily Masses during this week. I encourage you to find ways to incorporate these intentions in your daily prayers. We will pray for our country in an intentional way at Mass on Monday, July 4th at 9am. Also, our daily parish rosary at 11:35am will include these intentions.

**ARCHDIOCESE OF KISUMU**

The Catholic Archdiocese of Kisumu is located in Nyanza Province, Kenya. The first Missionaries, Mill Hill Fathers, came to the area in 1903. It was then part of the Vicariate of the Upper Nile. In 1925, it became a separate territory under the name of Prefecture Apostolic Kavirondo. It was raised to Vicariate Apostolic of Kisumu in 1932. It was established a diocese in 1953. In 1990, it was raised to Archdiocese of Kisumu. Its main mission of propagation of faith among the local living around Lake Victoria.

The Archdiocese covers an area of 4,616 km<sup>2</sup> with a population of about 3,443,161 of which 1,936,400 (56.2%) are Catholics. The main economic activity of the region is subsistence farming.

The Archdiocese has 63 parishes served by 111 priests (76 diocesans and 35 religious).

Currently, the archdiocese has 48 seminarians in various major seminaries in Kenya undergoing formation to priesthood. Your generous contribution will go towards formation of these future priests for the Archdiocese as well as for the universal church.


