

**Family Discussion of the Week: Holy Visitors**

Jesus said to Martha, "There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her." (Luke 10:42)

**Adults:** Which response to God's call is more natural to you - prayer or action? Why?

**Kids:** In the past week, when have you prayed and when have you done good things for others? Which could you do better?

**PRAYER AND SERVICE**

How do we bring balance and joy to our lives of prayer and service to our loving God?

In the Gospel today, Jesus tells Martha that her concern about doing the right thing as dictated by Jewish tradition might not be the best use of her energies. Her sister, Mary, who sits in rapt attention at Jesus' feet, should not be rebuked. Is Jesus trying to show Martha that she needs to make time for her spiritual nourishment?

Abraham and Sarah in the first reading seem to be just like Martha. And yet Abraham's eager welcome and joyful serving of his "visitors" seems almost spiritual. How like Paul, in the second reading, rejoicing in his service to the gospel!

We hear in the psalm that those who do justice will live in the Lord's presence. Prayer and service—what greater joy could there be?

## From the Pastor's Desk...

This Monday, July 18<sup>th</sup> I leave with 8 other pilgrims to visit the Catholic Shrines of England! We will visit Canterbury, Dover, Cambridge, Birmingham, Stratford-upon-Avon, Oxford and London while venerating and learning more about the saints of England like St. Augustine of Canterbury (6<sup>th</sup> Century), St. Thomas Becket (12<sup>th</sup> Century), St. Thomas More (16<sup>th</sup> Century), St. Edmond Campion (16<sup>th</sup> Century), the English Martyrs (16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Centuries) and St. John Henry Newman (19<sup>th</sup> Century). We will also visit the homes of the devotion of the brown scapular (St. Simon Stock in Ayelsford) and Our Lady of Walsingham (the biggest Marian Shrine in England). We return on Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup>. Know that I personally offer my pilgrimage for my spiritual family of Our Lady of Peace, that we can be open to the ways that God wants to renew, inspire, and transform our parish so that we may grow in our mission of Jesus Christ. Please pray for us as well, that we pilgrims can be open to the graces that God desires for us.

One other intention that we will offer on our pilgrimage is for the 25 youth and adult chaperones from OLP and the Erie community that will be attending Catholic Heart Work Camp this week (July 17-23), including Fr. Dave. They travel to New Jersey with hundreds of other youth from around the country to serve the needs of the area. We also pray for the team of young adults (18-25 years old) that will be leading their programs, prayers, and service.

I thank Fr. Shane Mathew (our rectory resident who works at Gannon University) who will be taking any emergencies and funerals while Fr. Dave and I are away (as well as extra Masses) and Fr. Phil Oriole and Fr. Ian McElrath who also will be helping cover daily Masses this week.


