Our faith is meant to guide and shape the way we live. If we are followers of Jesus Christ, we will treat others, especially the poor and vulnerable, fairly and justly. We will live with devotion to God and let our lives speak the truth of God's love for all. We will put first things first, or more precisely, put God and God's ways first, assured that when we do, everything else will fall into place.

From the Pastor's Desk...

Thank you to everyone who helped make the parish picnic last weekend a huge success! We had over 350 people participate in the outdoor Mass and over 600 people take part in the dinner and celebration that created an atmosphere of great energy and community. I specifically thank all the members of our picnic committee (the core of which is many of the Families Together Ministry) as well as those who volunteered to help in any way (a big shout out to the crew that spontaneously chipped in for cleanup at the end!). I also appreciate everyone who donated baskets for the raffle (we ended up with 81!) and to everyone who sold raffle tickets over the last 4 months. We ended up selling over 3,100 tickets which was short of our goal of 3,700 but still allowed us to raise over \$40,000 for our parish mission. It was truly an inspiring evening which should give us all great hope and awareness that the Holy Spirit is alive at OLP!

On a more sober note, as we have since the release of the Pennsylvania Grand Jury Report on Clergy Abuse back in 2018, we will have a holy hour for healing around the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows (September 15th). The specific intention of our Eucharistic Adoration will be the victim/survivors of abuse (especially at the hands of the church), the healing of the church and the sanctification of the clergy. **The Holy Hour will be Monday, September 19th at 7pm.**

May Jesus help us find healing and peace through the intercession of our Patroness, Our Lady of Peace and Our Lady of Sorrows! And may God bless our church and our world with healing and peace... and our week ahead!




