

Sunday's Readings:

Entrance Antiphon - The merciful love of the Lord fills the earth; / by the word of the Lord the heavens were made, alleluia.

First Reading - All peoples called by God will receive the gift of the Spirit if they repent and are baptized (Acts 2:14a, 36-41).

Psalm - My shepherd is the Lord; I shall not want (Psalm 23).

Second Reading - Once we were like straying sheep; but now we have been returned to the shepherd, our guardian (1 Peter 2:20b-25).

Gospel - The shepherd leads the sheep out into pastures of abundant life (John 10:1-10).

Family Discussion of the Week: Called to Be Shepherds

(The shepherd) goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice. (John 10:4)

Adults: How are you a shepherd to those in your care?

Kids: What will you do this week to show you love those around you?

EMMAUS AND THE MASS

Emmaus might as well be Brigadoon. We hear of it in this one story—and it's only in Luke—and then it disappears. The journey to Emmaus is one of the most beloved stories about Jesus, and yet the town is probably "mythical" in the truest sense. Like so much of life, this story is about the journey, not the destination. Running away from Jerusalem and their fears, probably going home in disillusionment, two of Jesus' disciples encounter a stranger on the road who, like a rabbi, is able to help them understand their experiences using his deep knowledge of scripture. Later, sharing a meal with him, they recognize the stranger as Jesus, and they return to Jerusalem to tell the others. How like our Mass—we hear the scriptures and an explanation of them, we share a meal, and then we go out to tell the good news.

From the Pastor's Desk...

A blessed Good Shepherd Sunday to you! Recall that this is also World Day of Prayer for Vocations (see below for more information on how we are celebrating that) and the weekend of our Good Shepherd Collection for the retired priests of our diocese. In that same vein, I also want to update you on the latest focus of our diocesan Good Shepherd, Bishop Persico.

Bishop Persico and our diocesan leadership met with parish leaders from Erie County a few weeks ago to continue the process of pastoral planning that he started in our Diocese in 2014. In late summer, they will announce the newest proposals for restructuring in the Catholic parishes of the county (which I do not anticipate having a direct impact on Our Lady of Peace). In the meantime, Bishop Persico has released a pastoral letter to the diocese which was printed in our bulletin last week. This was an update on where we stand as a diocesan church and reinforced the reasons and goals of this restructuring. I will also add some of my thoughts to compliment what the bishop says as he continues to update us throughout the next few months.

I encourage everyone to read Bishop Persico's letter to have a better understanding of the mind of the shepherd of our diocesan church as we move forward in this important work of reorganizing. 
WOMEN'S FAITH SHARING GROUP




