

Sunday's Readings:

Entrance Antiphon - O sing a new song to the Lord, / for he has worked wonders; / in the sight of the nations / he has shown his deliverance, alleluia.

Family Discussion of the Week: Jesus, the Way

I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6)

Adults: In a challenge you face right now, what will it mean to live the way of Jesus Christ? **Kids:** Name some ways you can be more like Jesus when you are playing with your friends or family?

FOLLOWING JESUS' WAY OF LOVE

Throughout the Easter season, we hear the story of the earliest Christian communities in readings from the Acts of the Apostles. We hear how the people grappled with what it meant to place their faith and trust in the Lord, understanding that doing so called them to live differently—to follow Jesus' way of love. This is more than a history lesson for us. As we hear how the people were drawn to Christ and learned to follow Jesus, we are invited to ask ourselves how fully we are taking the gospel to heart. Is Jesus our way, truth, and life? Do our daily actions announce the praises of the Lord?

Happy Month of Mary! Being a Marian Parish, it is good to remember that we seek to honor Mary in a special way throughout the month of May. This year's celebration began with the Our Lady of Peace School Mary's Day last Friday. Some other opportunities to honor Mary throughout this month are...

Saturday, May 13th, the feast of Our Lady of Fatima- we will celebrate at the 8am Mass and will pray a Rosary after Mass.

Monday, May 15th, the 46th Anniversary of the Dedication of Our Lady of Peace Church (1977)- we will have Masses at 7am and 12:10pm (with music) and a Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration at 7pm for our parish on its anniversary.

- **OLP Trip to Sight and Sound Theatre in Lancaster, PA for Production of "Moses" will be June 13-15, 2022. Call the office for more information.






