

#### **Sunday's Readings:**

**Entrance Antiphon** - Turn your ear, O Lord, and answer me; / save the servant who trusts in you, my God. / Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I cry to you all the day long.

**First Reading** - Eliakim is destined by God to be a father to those who live in Jerusalem (Isaiah 22:19-23).

**Psalm** - Your kindness, O Lord, lasts forever; remember those you have created (Psalm 138). **Second Reading** - How deep are the riches and the wisdom and the knowledge of God! (Romans 11:33-36).

Gospel - Jesus asked the disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:13-20).

#### Family Discussion of the Week: Representatives of Christ

He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." (Matthew 16:15-16)

**Adults:** If you were asked, how would you explain Jesus to a person who had not heard of him?

Kids: Who do you tell people Jesus is?

#### WHO IS JESUS?

Jesus poses the question "But who do you say I am?" in today's Gospel passage. It is a question posed to Peter and the disciples, to Matthew's first readers, and to the Church today. Peter's confession of faith in Jesus as Christ and Son of God was a culmination of what the disciples had experienced in their life with Jesus thus far. Jesus affirms Peter's declaration as a gift from God. But it was only the beginning of Peter's understanding of what these words actually meant, and how the disciples saw themselves in light of this truth. As Jesus and the disciples turned toward Jerusalem and to the cross, the disciples perhaps pondered their own identity, together with their dawning understanding of Jesus' identity. For us, the journey of faith, initiated and sustained by the Holy Spirit, means an ongoing reflection upon who Jesus is and who we are.

As we start a new school year throughout the Erie area, I wish our students, families, teachers, administrators and staff, a blessed and grace-filled school year! Here are a few updates on OLP school:

One- Fr. Dan Hoffman will be teaching 8<sup>th</sup> grade religion this year in tandem with Mary Beth Ek. Also, Fr. Dan is assigned to sacramental duty (chaplain) at Penn State Behrend while remaining the Parochial Vicar here. Please understand that he will not be able to be a part of our Sunday evening activities (although he still will be able to celebrate the 4:30pm Mass every so often).

**Two-** Emily Fluegel, OLP parishioner, has been hired as the new Vice Principal. Please keep Emily in your prayers as she takes on this new position to assist the principal, Shivani Suri.

**Three**- Lisa Panighetti, also an OLP parishioner, has taken a new position as Vice President of Curriculum for the Erie Catholic School System (ECSS- of which OLP School is part of). Lisa is returning to Erie Catholic School System (she was principal at OLP from 2017-21) after two years working for the Diocesan Catholic Schools Office.

The opening School Mass will be Wednesday, August 30<sup>th</sup> at 1:30pm which is open to the public, especially family members of school students. 

#### Other notes from the pastor...

- \*\*The Erie County Pastoral Planning Meeting is this Tuesday, August 29<sup>th</sup> I, and leaders from our parish will gather with other pastors and leaders of the Erie County Catholic Churches where Bishop Persico will present the proposal for the next phase of restructuring of the churches in our county. Please keep this important meeting in your prayers and we will report back to you next week.
- \*\*Special Masses this Week Monday, August 28<sup>th</sup>— St. Augustine, Bishop and Doctor of the Church (4/5<sup>th</sup> Century Northern Africa); Tuesday, August 29<sup>th</sup>- The Passion of St. John the Baptist; Wednesday, August 30<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, August 31<sup>st</sup> Weekdays in Ordinary Time; Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup>— Mass After the Harvest for World Day of Prayer for Care of Creation; Saturday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>- the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

- \*\*Becoming Catholic/ New RCIA Year RCIA (the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is the program through which adults become members of our Catholic faith through the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Our first meeting is Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm. If you are interested in becoming Catholic (meaning you were never baptized or were baptized in another Christian denomination) or want to complete your Catholic initiation (you were baptized Catholic but never Confirmed), please contact Tammie Mang in the Faith Formation Office to register for the program. If you have questions about the program, please call Tammie Mang, Fr. Dan or myself at the parish office.
- \*\*First Friday Adoration Another opportunity to grow in Eucharistic Amazement this week is our adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for First Friday (September 1st). Recall that we have extended adoration from 7am to 7pm during the National Eucharistic Revival.
- \*\*The OLP Raffle is the main fundraiser of the parish supporting the work and mission of OLP. So far 360 families have participated by buying/selling 2,800 tickets. If everyone does their part, we can reach our goal of 3,800; that's just (2) tickets per family. When we all do our part and work together, incredible things can happen. Remember for every 10 tickets bought/sold you receive a bonus ticket for all the prize giveaways. The \$15,000 in cash prizes will be drawn at the parish picnic on September 9th. If you are able to sell more tickets, stop by the office.
- \*\*OLP Athletics Golf Outing Forms are available in the church vestibule to sign up to golf or to sponsor this event on Friday, September 15<sup>th</sup> at Noon at Beechwood Golf Course. More info on page 9.
- \*\*National Eucharistic Congress The 3-year Eucharistic Revival in the United States culminates next summer with a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis on July 17-21, 2024. OLP reserved 25 early bird congress tickets at a cost of \$200 (rather than \$300 that they are now) for this once in a lifetime opportunity. As of this writing there are 15 spots available. I am working with the Diocese of Erie to put together a bus trip to the Congress that will eventually offer housing and transportation that is not included in your congress ticket; for now, though, we need to have commitments for the congress tickets. So, you have until August 31st to claim one of the 15 remaining tickets at \$200. In September, they will be made available to the rest of the diocese on a first come first served basis. Please drop off payment of \$200/per ticket at the parish office. Checks should be made out to "OLP" with Eucharistic Congress in the memo line. Look for more information coming soon with details on the housing and transportation package. I will be helping lead the trip so I hope you will consider joining me for the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in the past 83 years.




