

Jesus said, "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you." (John 15:12)

Adults: How is love of others connected to love for God?

*Kids:* Who needs Jesus' love this week? How can you show them his love?

#### LOVE ONE ANOTHER

In the Gospel for the Sixth Sunday of Easter we are met with an extraordinary challenge: Jesus commands us to "love one another as I love you" (John 15:12). The letter from John echoes this command. Of course, we are to love those in our family, those we work with, those we like. But the scriptures make clear that we are also to love those we never notice, those we purposely avoid, and even those we are tempted to despise.

In this Sunday's selection from the Acts of the Apostles Peter shows us how far God's love extends, and how far our love should extend in response. Peter realizes that God no longer "shows partiality" to the Jews, sharing divine love exclusively with them. Christ has revealed that God's love extends to all people, and so should ours. ### From the Pastor's Desk...

Jesus is Risen, Alleluia! This week we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord on Thursday, May 9th. We will have Masses at 5:30pm Wednesday evening and 7am, 9am (School Mass) and 12:10pm on Thursday. Recall that St. Luke in Acts 1 tells us that the Ascension occurred 40 days after the Resurrection. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 665) says, "Christ's Ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain, whence he will come again (cf. Acts 1:11); this humanity in the meantime hides him from the eyes of men (cf. Col 3:3)." Every Sunday, we profess the Ascension in the Nicene Creed: "(Jesus) ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end." Jesus' ascension concluded his work on earth to bring about our redemption that he began on Good Friday. (CCC no. 662) "Jesus Christ, the head of the Church, precedes us into the Father's glorious kingdom so that we, the members of his body, may live in the hope of one day being with him forever" (no. 666). Another way to say this is that the Ascension is the completion of the Paschal mystery, that Jesus suffered, died, rose and ascended into heaven to save us from sin and death.

So let's celebrate the Ascension of the Lord with renewed vigor this year at Our Lady of Peace. May God bless our celebration of the Ascension and our 6<sup>th</sup> Week of Easter ahead!

- \*\*Catholic Services Appeal 2024 (CSA) UPDATE We presently have 390 pledges for \$193,253. Recall that our overall goal is \$200,000 with our annual Diocesan assessment at \$144,333 and the cost of our church mortar pointing project being \$55,000. We are so close! Please prayerfully consider a pledge if you have not given one yet so we can complete this maintenance on our church building.







