

# Family Discussion of the Week: Gift of Peace

Jesus said to the sea, "Peace! Be still!" Then the wind ceased, and there was a dead calm. He said to them, "Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith?" (Mark 4:39-40)

Adults: When has the Lord calmed the stormy seas of your life?

Kids: What fear would you like the Lord to help you overcome?

### THE WIND AND THE SEA

Living along the shores of Lake Superior-the "big lake," as the locals call it-you can often hear the advice, "Respect the lake; don't take it for granted." People who know Lake Superior respect its power and watch out for its many moods. Sunken ships and boats crushed into kindling are testimonies to what the lake can do.

The readings of this Sunday evoke our memories of the lake, of the mighty Mississippi River, or of the ocean itself. Who but God can control these mighty waters and set limits to their advance? The lake described in today's Gospel was a body of water subject to sudden storms and churned into dangerous waves by terrible winds.



# From the Pastor's Desk...

After all the parish restructuring and assignment of clergy in Erie County over the last few months, the initial plan was that Our Lady of Peace would be unaffected and Fr. Dan would stay with us for another year. But the recent unexpected death of one of our diocesan pastors has changed that and we announced last weekend that Bishop Persico has now assigned Fr. Dan as the parochial administrator of St. Titus Parish in Titusville with its secondary churches of St. Walburga in Titusville and Immaculate Conception in Mageetown. To replace Fr. Dan, the Bishop has assigned Fr. Nick Fratus to OLP. Fr. Nick was ordained in 2022 with Fr. Chris Wheeler and Fr. Ben Daghir. He has spent time at St. George and St. Peter in Erie over the last 2 years. These assignments will take place on July 9th.

Obviously, this is difficult news; but we know it's part of the rhythm here at Our Lady of Peace since we are one of only a few parishes in our Diocese that have a parochial vicar. Hopefully we can focus on being grateful for the gift of having Fr. Dan with us for a year and that we are blessed to have Fr. Nick available to take his place.

Fr. Dan is away this weekend at the Youth Conference in Steubenville, OH (let's keep him, Sarah Beaver and the other 30 youth and chaperones in our prayers this weekend!) and he will be away on vacation next weekend so we will have a chance to say goodbye and thank you to him the weekend of July 6-7. Fr. Dan will be around after all the Masses that weekend. There will be coffee and doughnuts in the vestibule at the 9am and Ham Masses and Sundaes for Sunday after the 4:30pm Mass.

May God bless Fr. Dan and Fr. Nick in this time of transition, and our week ahead!

- \*\*Distribution of Holy Communion Adjustments The Parish Liturgy Committee is implementing the following changes to the distribution of Holy Communion in July.

One- We will have two ministers of the Precious Blood at the 5pm Saturday evening Mass. Ideally, we would have the Precious Blood at every Mass but due to limitations in ministers we cannot.

Two- we will no longer ask the ministers to sanitize their hands in the sanctuary. Ministers will do this in the pews before they approach the sanctuary (with their own bottle of sanitizer). Extra bottles of sanitizer are in the sacristy. Let me know if you have questions about these adjustments.
