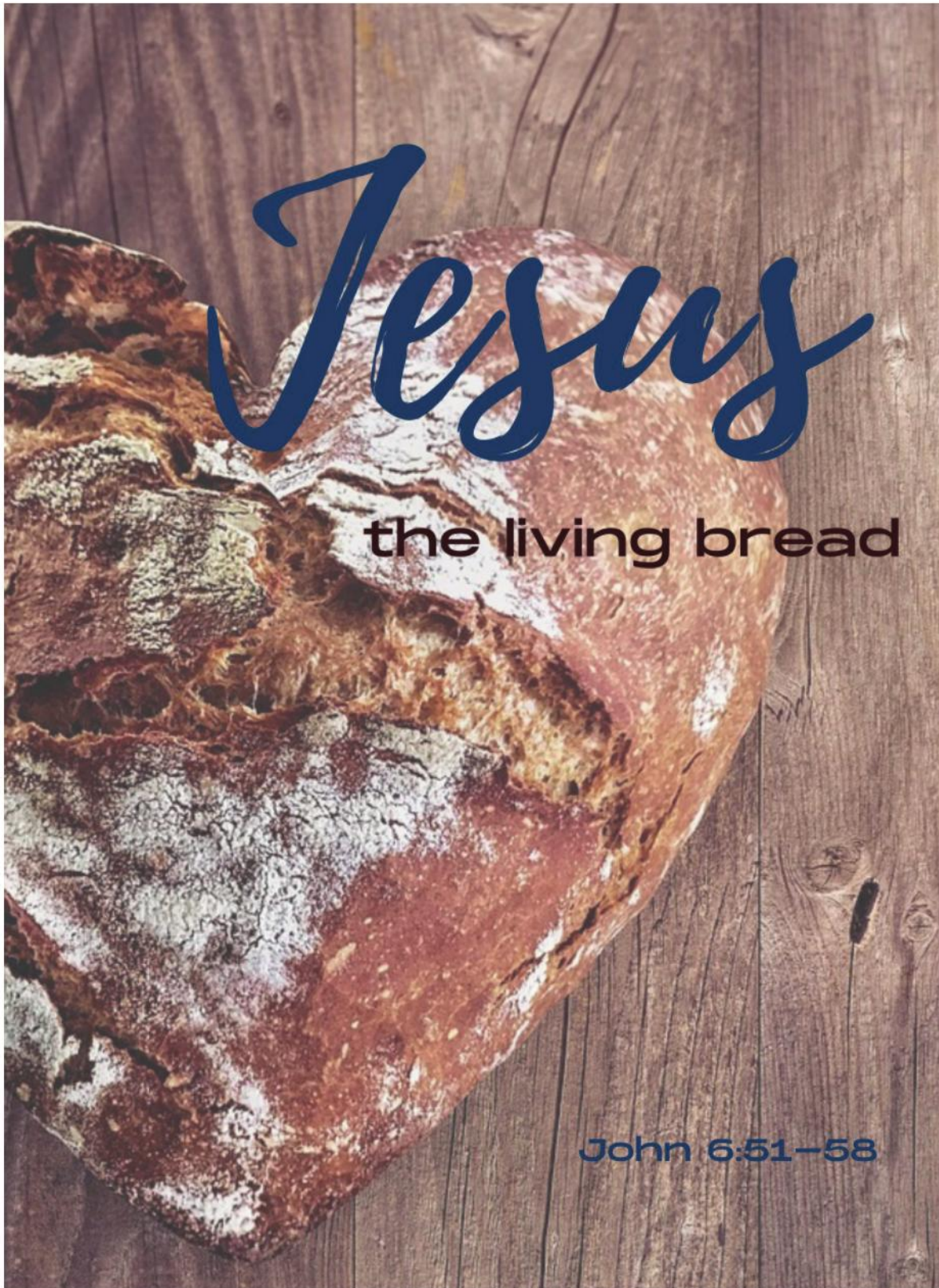

Family Discussion of the Week: Promise of Eternal Life

Jesus said, "Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day." (John 6:54)

Adults: How does Jesus' promise of eternal life affect the way you live today?

Kids: How often do you think about heaven? Does it make a difference in the choices you make?

THIS EUCHARISTIC FEAST

Some things about human nature don't change, even over the course of centuries. When we celebrate a holiday, we have a meal; when we celebrate a significant event, we have a feast. In today's first reading, Lady Wisdom is setting a feast, a sign of celebrating the covenant that Israel has with God. Israel's central remembrance of its saving Exodus covenant is the Passover meal. So it is natural—and not coincidental—that the Christian celebration of the new covenant sealed by the blood of Christ on the cross happens at a meal, our Eucharist, offered first by Jesus in the context of Passover remembrance. It is easy for us, sometimes, to forget the very long and rich religious and human origins of our eucharistic feasting on the bread and cup that are the Body and Blood of Jesus. Today, and for the next few Sundays that we hear the "Bread of Life" discourse from John, let us bring to mind the loving covenant that God makes with us, and be filled with great joy at this marvelous feast that we have come to attend!

From the Pastor's Desk...

We are in the midst of what I like to call "Mary's Octave" between two of her great August feasts, the Assumption on August 15th and the Queenship of Mary on August 22nd (which is 8 days... therefore octave). Recall that last year we established August 22nd as our parish feast day. Last year we had solemn evening prayer and Benediction to celebrate the feast with the hope that we would slowly build upon that with more celebration. To that end, Thursday, August 22nd will be a day of Eucharistic Adoration which will start after the 7am Mass and continue until Solemn Evening Prayer and Benediction at 7pm. Fr. Dennis Veltri, who was the parochial vicar at OLP for 6 years from 1991-1997 under Msgr. Ernie Daley, will preach at the liturgy. We have invited the priests of the Diocese to join us that evening for prayer as well as a dinner beforehand.

We will also have a communal feast day celebration the night before with a bonfire and outdoor movie. The bonfire will begin at 7:30pm by the pavilion and the movie, "Up," will start at 8:30pm. Smores, popcorn and water will be available, or you are welcome to bring your own drinks and snacks. Please bring your own chair or blanket to watch the movie. Rain location will be in the cafeteria.

Join us as we come together as a spiritual family to honor and celebrate our patroness, Our Lady, Queen of Peace!

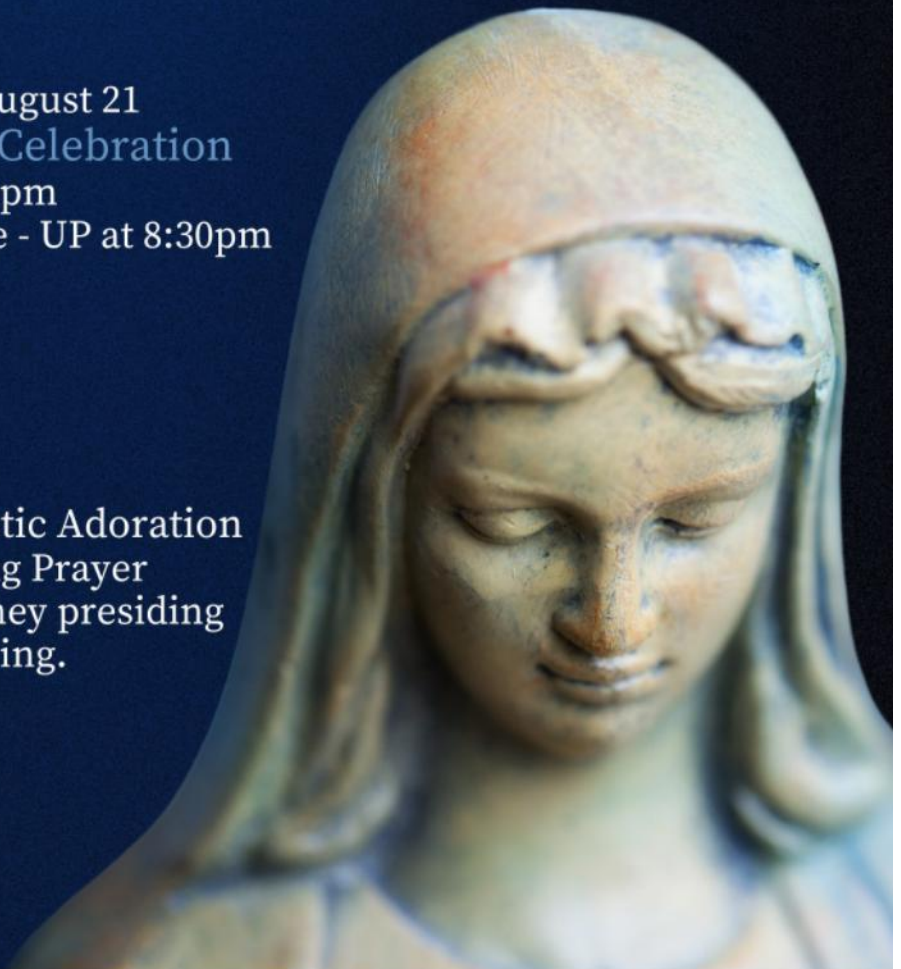

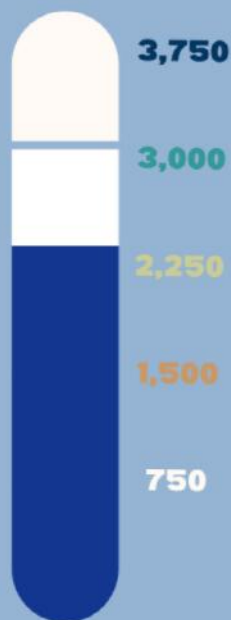

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments - Diocesan

Requirements for working with children: Working alongside the Bishop, the Office for the Protection of Children and Youth reinforces the ongoing implementation of policies and procedures that protect children. All clergy, employees, and volunteers in the Diocese of Erie who work with children must undergo criminal record checks. The diocesan Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth screening guidelines and abuse prevention training programs emphasize the importance of knowing the employees and volunteers who have access to children in our schools and parishes. Parents should remain vigilant in insisting that those with access to their children have gone through an application process and obtained the required clearances and trainings before being granted access to their children. 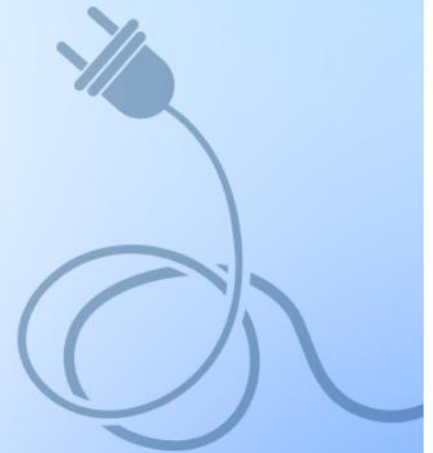


