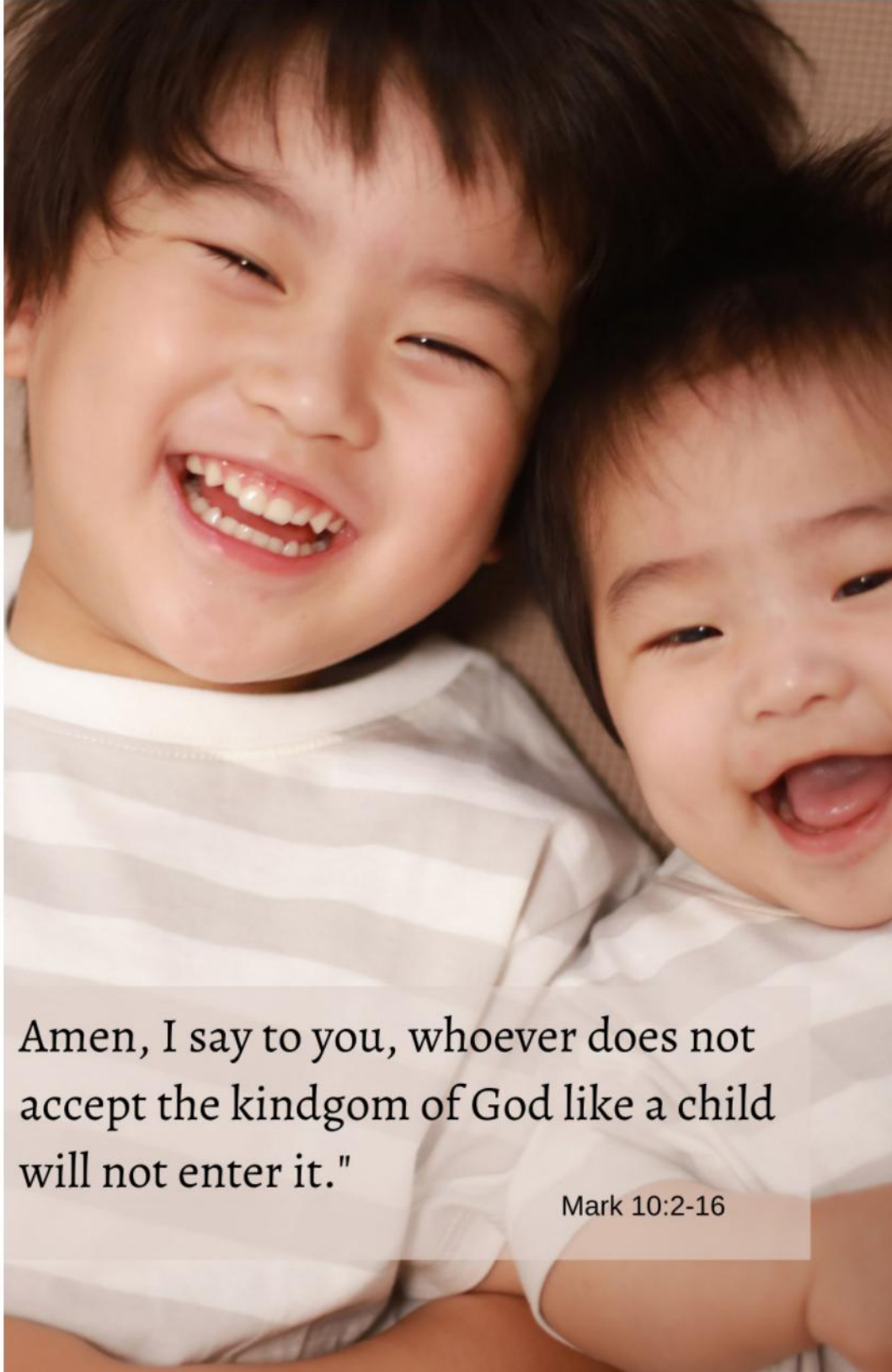

**Family Discussion of the Week: Childlike Faith**

Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it." (Mark 10:15)

**Adults:** What could keep you from embracing the kingdom of God like a little child?

**Kids:** How do you feel when you hear the wonderful stories of God's love for you?

**HE EMBRACED THEM AND BLESSED THEM**

Today Jesus stresses how children embody the reign of God. They are trusting and loving and have hearts that are open to love. They are joyful when they are made aware of God's love for them, and are eager to return that love. This is the model Jesus holds out to us if we want to welcome the reign of God. We need to have open, loving hearts. We must drop our defenses, however we came by them, and welcome Christ's love for us with joy. This is impossible for us on our own. Only the grace of God will enable us to do this, but that grace is freely and generously given. We have only to accept it.

I invite and encourage you to be part of our parish Eucharistic Consecration this Fall. The Eucharistic liturgy is the source and summit of all that we do and are as a Parish. The need for us to grow in our appreciation of, and relationship with God and each other through the Eucharist is never ending. So, in our third year of the National Eucharistic Revival, I ask you to participate in this Eucharistic Consecration. What is a Consecration? It is a promise of renewal, a re-commitment and deeper devotion to Jesus Christ through a specific person or mystery of the faith, in this case through the Eucharist. We will be using Matthew Kelly's book "*33 Days to Eucharistic Glory*" which is provided for free to all thanks to generous benefactors. The Consecration begins October 20th and ends on November 24th.

**\*\*Erie Rosary March** I will be the guest homilist for the annual Rosary March which takes place on Sunday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at St. Peter Cathedral and the streets of downtown Erie at 2pm. I encourage you to join me. You can join the walk along the streets or if unable to walk, you can remain at the Cathedral in prayer. I will preach at the prayer service which takes place in the Cathedral once the March has ended, around 3:00-3:15pm.

Remember that October is the Month of the Rosary and this is an excellent opportunity to pray this powerful prayer with Bishop Persico and many other members of the Catholic Church of Erie and to grow in our devotion to our patroness, Our Lady of Peace.

**\*\*Our Annual Pet Blessing will take place on Sunday, October 6th at 1:00pm in the parking lot in front of the main entrance to the school.** We hold the pet blessing on the Sunday closest to the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi (October 4<sup>th</sup>) who is the patron saint of animals and the environment.

**\*\*Respect Life Month** October is Respect Life Month in the US Catholic Church and so we pray for the recognition of the dignity of all human life from conception to natural death. Typically in our Catholic Social Justice Teaching we have a particular concern for life that is the most vulnerable- the unborn, the elderly, the imprisoned, the poor, those with mental illness, those with special needs, immigrants, the homeless. Please keep this intention in mind in a special way this month.

**\*\*All Souls Day Memorial Service** The memorial service for All Souls Day will be held on Monday, November 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:00PM. We pray for all those who have died and had funeral services through Our Lady of Peace over the past year. We welcome also praying for and with our parish families who have lost loved ones in the last year whose funerals were not at OLP. So any parishioners of OLP can notify the office if your spouse, parent or child died since last November 2<sup>nd</sup> and we will include them by name in our service and make a candle for them. Please let us know by Monday, October 21<sup>st</sup>.

**Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments - Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments – Is Your Child Street Smart?** Being street smart means knowing how to keep yourself safe from strangers when you're alone or with other kids. When your street smart you know your way around, you know how to handle yourself in tough situations and you can "read" people. Teach your child who are strangers - (-anyone they do not know or kind of know- and to never approach a strangers vehicle. Teach to your child to always tell you where they are. Teach your child to always go with a friend or two whether walking to school, bike riding or going to the store. Pick out safe spots where your child can go and get help. Places like police stations, stores, restaurants. Teach them how to spot safe places on their route and to avoid places that aren't safe.
