

Family Discussion of the Week: Feed My Sheep

When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him,, "Yes,, Lord; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my lambs." (John 21:15)

Adults: In what ways are you answering Jesus' command to Peter to "feed my sheep?" Kids: What do you do to take care of others as Jesus asked Peter to do?

LIFELONG SERVICE

"I am going fishing." What an announcement! If asked who made it, and not told it was a Bible quote, we might guess "Grandpa" or "Uncle Fred," or admit, "I said that last summer!" But it is a Bible quote, from today's Gospel. The person who said it also once declared, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Yes, it's Peter! So today's announcement seems quite the comedown. Last Sunday Jesus said, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." But Peter seems determined to return to his pre-apostolic occupation, until Jesus intervenes, making Peter's later announcement deeper, "Lord, you know that I love you," and Peter's apostolic calling clearer, "Tend my sheep." Peter does so. Acts presents the consequences: Peter declares, "We must obey God rather than men." As Revelation proclaims, "Worthy is the Lamb"—to receive Peter's lifelong service, and ours. From the Pastor's Desk...

Jesus is Risen, Alleluia! He is Risen Indeed, Alleluia! Our parish leadership has reinitiated the process for a significant renovation to our Church and Parish Campus that initially began back in 2018. More will be coming in the weeks and months ahead about that RE-CREATION plan but for now I want to ask our entire parish to join our parish patron, Our Lady of Peace, in the "upper room" to seek the inspiration of the Holy Spirit for a new Pentecost for our parish that will lead to a new birth of Jesus at our parish through this process. Mary gave birth to Jesus in Bethlehem over 2000 years ago, and then gave birth to His Mystical Body, the Church, at Pentecost in Jerusalem, and has continued to help give birth to Jesus throughout the world over the last 2000 years (most notably as Our Lady of Guadalupe in the Americas in the 1500s). I ask every parishioner to join me in imploring Mary to help give birth to Jesus anew at Our Lady of Peace Parish in Erie, Pennsylvania in the next five years.

The prayer plan will look like this... between May 15th (the anniversary of our Church Dedication) and September 30th (the anniversary of the founding of our parish) everyone in our parish is asked to pray different Marian prayers. We will have some creative ways for you to acknowledge the prayers you have said with the hope that we will have accumulated thousands of prayers to Mary for this purpose of new birth at OLP by September 30th that will pave the way for the next steps in our re-creation process in the Fall.

"Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and we shall be recreated and you shall renew the face of the earth. Amen." Our Lady of Peace... pray for us!!

**Pilgrimage to Italy
Other pilgrims will be starting our Eucharistic Miracles of Italy
Pilgrimage. When I first planned this trip, the main focus was a pilgrimage to celebrate the last months of the National
Eucharistic Revival that the US Bishops had scheduled from 2022-2025. I soon realized it would also coincide with the 2025 Jubilee for the Church and that was such an added blessing. Now with the death of Pope Francis, we could be in Rome for the conclave, for the announcement of the new Pope, for the installation of the new Pope or for the new Pope's first audience so that adds some extra anticipation in the midst of the sadness of losing Pope Francis.

Part of the focus of every pilgrimage I lead is to offer prayer for my parish and all their intentions so please know that I and all of our pilgrims will be offering our pilgrimage for you, my spiritual family. Please pray for us as well. I thank Fr. Nick for keeping things going while I am gone as well as Fr. Shane Mathew (priest in residence at OLP) for taking on extra Masses. I also thank retired priest, Fr. Ray Hahn, for covering several Masses. We return on Friday, May 16th in time for OLP Serves on May 17th and the Knights of Columbus Breakfast on May 18th Arrivederci!

- **Death of Pope Francis/Conclave to Elect New Pope

 Let us continue to pray for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis and thank God for his ministry of shepherding the Universal Catholic Church for the last 12 years. I will be writing more about my thoughts on his legacy next week but for now I just want to keep encouraging our prayers and gratitude to God. Also, as of my writing of this bulletin, the schedule is not clear for the timing of the conclave which will elect the new Pope but let us ask for the inspiration of the Holy Spirit to guide those who will be electing our new Supreme Pontiff, that they are instruments of God's will for our church.
- **"OLP Faithful to the Finish" 5K Our 11th Annual "Faithful to the Finish" 5K Run/Walk at Presque Isle State Park at 8am is NEXT SATURDAY (May 10th). Part of our mission at Our Lady of Peace is to ensure that the Christian way of life continues not just in our generation, but for generations to come. One newer way we can do that is by supporting our new Parish Endowment that we have established through the Catholic Foundation of Erie. For the last 4 years all funds raised by our annual Faithful to the Finish 5K has gone to the OLP Parish Endowment. We started the endowment with \$10,000 in 2022 and it is now up to \$57,765 so let's keep it growing! Unfortunately, I will not be at the 5K this year because of the pilgrimage to Italy (May 5-16) but know I will be with you in spirit and prayer! Look elsewhere in the bulletin for more information on how to sponsor or participate in the 5K!
- **Catholic Services Appeal 2025 As of April 22nd, we have 360 Pledges for \$208,242. Thank you to all who have pledged! We have exceeded our assessment to the Diocese of Erie (\$151,600) but our goal is 400 pledges for \$227,600 and our parish project is the renovation of the rectory kitchen as well as the replacing of the flooring for the first floor. Please consider making a pledge if you have not already. Pledge envelopes are at the doors of the church or at the parish office.

**Our Parish Jubilee for Bishops (June 25)/Priests (June 25-27)/
Deacons (Feb 21- 23)/ Seminarians (June 23-24)/ and
Consecrated Life (Oct 8-9) will be the weekend of May 10/11.
Remember the dates parenthesis are when the Vatican will be celebrating these jubilees but we have grouped them for our celebrations at OLP. That weekend is the 4th Sunday of Easter and also traditionally called Good Shepherd Sunday and has been designated as World Day of Prayer for Vocations for years.
Recall that at our monthly jubilee Masses, we include those designated in our intercessions, we pray Pope Francis' Jubilee Prayer and we offer a special blessing for the "jubilarians" at the end of Mass (in this case, bishops, priests, deacons, seminarians and those in consecrated life). Please join us in praying for all of those who have responded to these important religious vocations in our church.


