

POST-SUMMER CHALLENGES

With any luck, summer delights will continue a while past last weekend's Labor Day: refreshing recreation (with maybe an occasional swim) or enjoyable relaxation on the deck (with tasty outdoor grilling). Truth is, for some of us, this year's Labor Day came way too early. With many schools back in session for a while already, mealtimes and driving schedules needed readjustment to coordinate youth sports with adult commitments. Some religious education and parish programs resumed, too. No surprise, then, that this weekend's scriptures sound a little like post-summer challenges. For instance, Wisdom reminds us that believers in God can never be content with "timid deliberations" and "unsure plans." Paul challenges longtime friend and follower Philemon to "let the good you do be voluntary." Jesus instructs "great crowds" traveling with him—including us—on three things necessary for all true disciples to accomplish. On this early autumn weekend, our scriptures describe disciples' lifelong labors.

****There will be a new Synod Listening Session at OLP on Monday, September 15th from 6:30-8pm in the school cafeteria.**

The topic will be the baptismal call of the Catholic Laity. This is following up on the synod on synodality that took place throughout the universal Catholic Church between 2022-2024. Listening sessions like this will be held at parishes throughout the Diocese of Erie throughout September and a Diocesan Report will then be submitted to the US Catholic Conference by November 1st. Then a US report will be submitted to the Vatican by the end of 2025. More information will be coming on our listening session in the next few weeks but for now mark your calendars to be a part of this ongoing movement in the church re-initiated by Pope Francis and being continued by Pope Leo XIV.

****The next step in our Parish Vision and Re-Creation Plan** after our 4 and a half months of intentional prayer is a parish mission. **The Mission will take place October 5-7, 2026 and is called "Passionate Faith: Growing in Holiness and Mission with Nate Schaaf from Amazing Parish."** It will involve nightly sessions of inspiration and prayer from 6:30-8pm. Recall that OLP has been participating in the Amazing Parish Movement since spring of 2022 and Nate has been our coach since Fall of 2022. Please mark your calendars and make every effort to be a part of this important step of our PVRP!


Knights of Columbus Soccer Challenge






